

# Waffle Weave Dishcloth

This pattern makes a great, inexpensive dishcloth or hotpad. The textures from the front post double crochet stitches make it nice for scrubbing your pots and pans and make it thick enough to use as a hotpad.

## Supplies:

- 1 ball Sugar n Cream Worsted Cotton (70g, 120yds per ball)
- J Hook

Guage not important



## Instructions

**Foundation:** Chain 32

(NOTE: You can alternatively do 30 foundation double crochets. If you do so, skip row 1)

**Row 1:** dc in 2nd stitch from the hook, and continue to dc across (30 stitches)

**Row 2:** \*dc, fpdc\* across, ending with a dc in the turning chain, turn, ch 2

Repeat row 2 until just short of desired length

**Final Row:** dc in each stitch, ending with a dc in the turning chain. Cut yarn and fasten off

**Border:** join yarn to any dc. dc around, (dc, 2ch, dc) in corner stitch for each corner.

### Special Stitches:

#### *Front Post Double Crochet (fpdc)*

Yarn over; pass hook from right to left under the front of the post of the next stitch; yarn over and pull yarn under the post. (3 loops on hook).

Yarn over and pull through 2 loops; yarn over and pull through remaining 2 loops
