

Chevron PomPom Bookmark

Equipment needed:

4.5mm needles

5mm crochet hook

20gms of 8ply or DK yarn in two colours.

I used Marvel Soft 8 Ply in Magenta for my main colour (MC) and Light Pink for my contrasting colour (CC)

You can substitute any size yarn and the recommended needle size for that yarn. Adjust the crochet hook size so that it's larger than the needle size. Gauge is not important for this project.

Chevron pattern:

Row 1 (MC): Purl

Row 2 (MC): K1, KF&B, K4, sl1 K1 PSSO, K2tog K4, KF&B, K1

Row 3 (CC): Purl

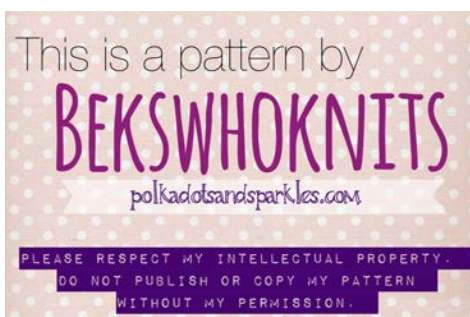
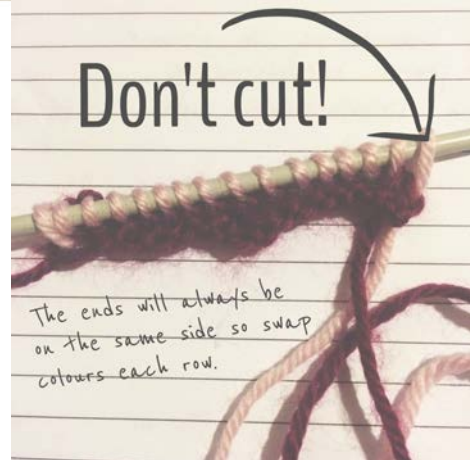
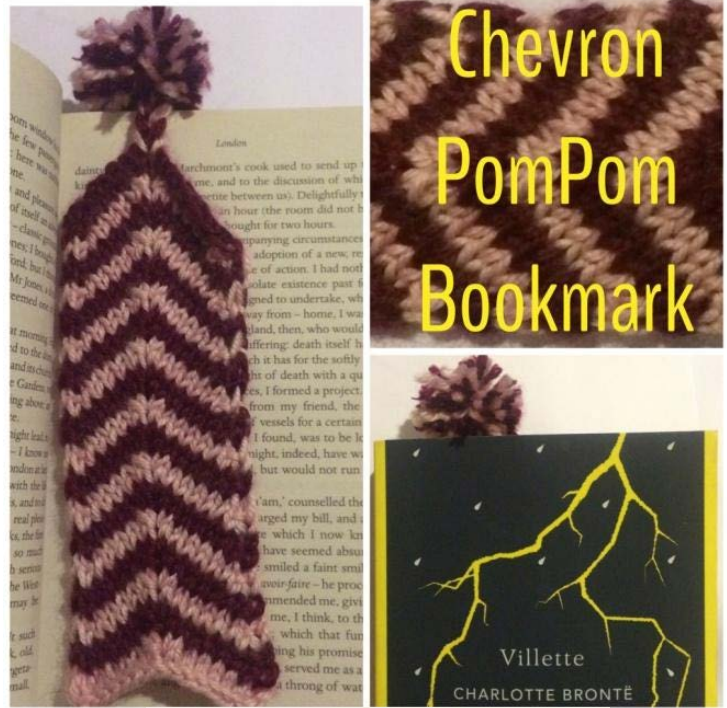
Row 4 (CC): Repeat row 2

Pattern instructions:

Cast on 16 stitches.

Follow chevron pattern until bookmark is the desired length.

Bind off.



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To attach the pompom:

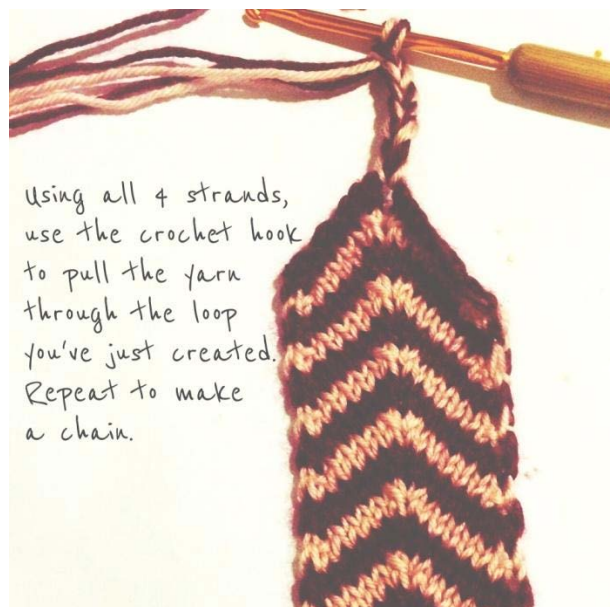
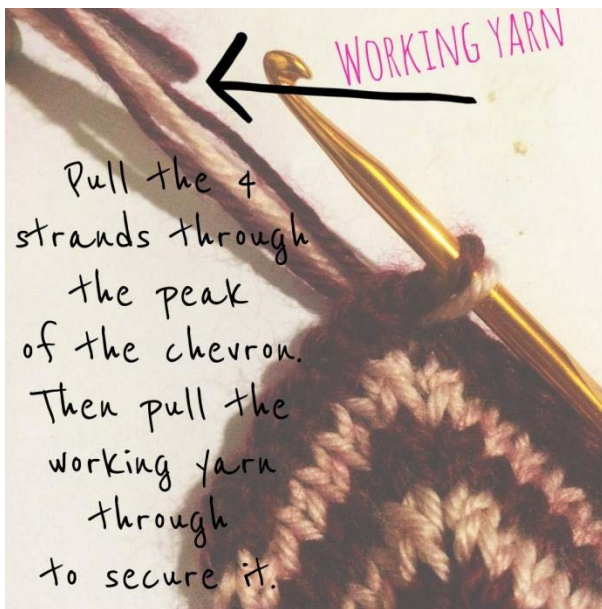
Cut a long length of the two colours holding them both together.

Using a crochet hook, pull the yarn through the middle of the chevron (This will be your cast on edge).

There should be a short edge on one side, and a long length on the other.

Using the 4 strands of yarn, create a 10 cm chain.

Pull the working yarn through the loop to close the chain.



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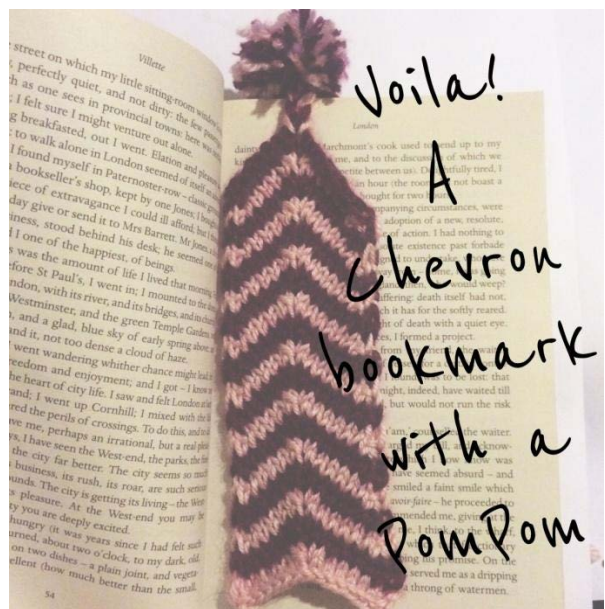
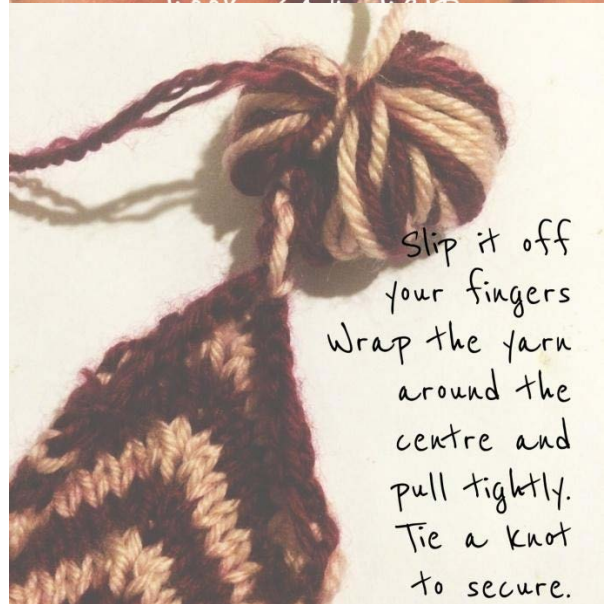
Holding the chain in your left hand between your index finger and middle finger, wrap the yarn around those two fingers. Leave enough so you can loop that between your fingers, slip the yarn off your fingers and tighten the loop and tie it in a knot.

Then cut through the edges and trim your pompom.

voila! A completed bookmark!

The chain and pompom by itself also makes a suitable bookmark.

Just make a longer chain!
