

# Lovely Ruffly Shawl

I was searching for a circular garter stitch shawl pattern, and when I couldn't find one I decided to create my own.

There are only 4 skills needed for this pattern so it's suitable for beginners, while still creating an interesting finished object.

Gauge isn't important to the finished product so you can use any yarn you like. So you get the right amount of drape use slightly larger needles than suggested for the yarn type.

## You will need to know how to:

- Cast on
- Knit
- Increase by knitting into the front & back of the same stitch (KF&B)
- Bind off



## Equipment needed:

5mm circular needle or really long straight needles.

100g of 4 ply or fingering weight yarn (or more if you want to make a larger shawl)

## Pattern instructions:

Cast on 16 stitches.

Row 1: KF&B, K14, KF&B

Row 2 – 5: KF&B, Knit to last stitch, KF&B

**Row 6:** KF&B across entire row

Row 7 – 17: KF&B, Knit to last stitch, KF&B

**Row 18:** KF&B across entire row

Row 19 – 53 – KF&B, Knit to last stitch, KF&B

**Row 54:** KF&B across entire row

Row 55 – 78 – KF&B, Knit to last stitch, KF&B

**Row 79:** KF&B across entire row

**Row 80:** KF&B across entire row

Bind off all stitches and weave in ends.
