## MEASUREMENTS

Approx Finished Size 90cm x 90cm

## BENDIGO WOOLLEN MILLS YARN REQUIREMENTS x 200g BALLS

40 Ply x 6

Yarn quantities can vary between knitters and are therefore approximate requirements. Use only Bendigo yarns as specified.

## ACCESSORIES

A 15.00mm circular knitting needle or size needle to give correct tension, cable needle.

## TENSION

6.5 sts and 9 rows to 10cm over stocking stitch using 15.00mm needles. It is essential to check your tension before commencing this blanket, therefore work a tension square. If there are more stitches use larger needles. If there are less stitches use smaller needles.

## ABBREVIATIONS

C4B = Slip 2 sts onto cable needle and hold in back, K2, K2 from cable needle.

K = knit, P = purl, rep = repeat, st/s = stitch/es.

## BLANKET

Using a 15.00mm needle, cast on 67 sts.

**1st Row (right side):** K3, \*P1, K4, rep from \* to last 4 sts, P1, K3.

**2nd Row:** K3, \*K1, P4, rep from \* to last 4 sts, K1, K3.

### ***Beg Cable Pattern***

**1st Row (right side):** K3, \*P1, K4, rep from \* to last 4 sts, P1, K3.

**2nd and all alt Rows:** K3, \*K1, P4, rep from \* to last 4 sts, K4.

**3rd Row:** K3, \*P1, C4B, P1, K4, rep from \* to last 4 sts, P1, K3.

**5th Row:** As 1st row.

**7th Row:** As 1st row.

**9th Row:** As 1st row.

**11th Row:** K3, \*P1, K4, P1, C4B, rep from \* to last 4 sts, P1, K3.

**13th Row:** As 1st row.

**15th Row:** K3, \*P1, K4, P1, C4B, rep from \* to last 4 sts, P1, K3.

**17th Row:** As 1st row.

**19th Row:** As 1st row.

**21st Row:** As 1st row.

**23rd Row:** K3, \*P1, C4B, P1, K4, rep from \* to last 4 sts, P1, K3.

**24th Row:** As 2nd row.

Rep last 24 rows of cable pattern until work measures approx 87cm ending with a 24th pattern row.

**1st Row (right side):** K3, \*P1, K4, rep from \* to last 4 sts, P1, K3.

**2nd Row:** K3, \*K1, P4, rep from \* to last 4 sts, K1, K3.

**3rd Row:** K3, \*P1, K4, rep from \* to last 4 sts, P1, K3.

Cast off loosely in pattern.

Sew in ends. Press lightly with a warm iron and a damp cloth.
