

### Requires...

- 50g DK weight yarn, approx 90m in length (I used Rowan all seasons cotton)
- 4mm Straight Needles
- Stitch Markers

### Abbreviations...

- K Knit  
 P Purl  
 M1 Make a stitch by picking up and knitting the thread between two stitches  
 PM Place Stitch Marker



### Pattern...

#### Make 2

#### Cuff and mitt to base of thumb:

- To begin Cast on 32 Stitches using the thumb method, leaving a 10" end for stitching up mitt.
- Row 1 (P1, K3) repeat to end, right side
- Row 2 (K1, P3) repeat to end, wrong side. These 2 rows set cuff rib pattern.
- Rows 3-12 Repeat rows 1 and 2
- Row 13 K to end
- Row 14 P to end
- Rows 15 to 28, Repeat rows 13&14 (Stocking Stitch) ending with a wrong side row
- Row 29 K7, M1 PM, K1, M1, K to end
- Row 30 P to end
- Row 31 K to Marker, M1, K1, M1, K to end
- Rows 32 to 36, Repeat rows 30&31
- Row 37 K to Marker, M1, K1, turn work (12 working stitches)

#### Shape Thumb

- Row 1 P to end
- Row 2 K to end
- Row 3 (K3, P1) repeat to end, wrong side
- Row 4 (P3, K1) repeat to end, right side
- Row 5&6, Repeat rows 3&4 rib pattern
- Cast off Knit wise leaving end for stitching

### Shape Fingerless fingers

- Row 1 Join yarn at base edge of thumb at point where you turned work (leave short end for weaving in), M1, K to end
- Row 2 P to end
- Row 3 K to end
- Row 4 P to end
- Row 5 K to end
- Row 6 P to end
- Row 7 (K1, P3) repeat to end, right side
- Row 8 (P1, K3) repeat to end, wrong side
- Rows 9&10 Repeat rows 7&8
- Cast off knit wise, leave short end for weaving in

### Finishing...

Fold Mitt along blue fold lines (right side out)

Using cast on tail (red), mattress stitch cuff to where you turned for thumb, continue to stitch up main hand section

Using cast off thumb tail (green), mattress stitch from top of thumb to base

Weave in all ends
