

Requires...

Small amounts of DK yarn approx 10g of each colour (I used Stylecraft Special DK in Cream, Walnut and Lipstick)
3.5mm DPN's or Circular Needle
Toy Stuffing
Darning Needle

Abbreviations...

CO Cast On
K Knit
KFB Knit into the front and back of the stitch (increasing by one)
K2tog Knit 2 stitches together (decreasing by one)



Pattern...

Bun

CO 6 in Brown/Bun Colour, Join in the round and spread stitches over two needles

1. KFB into each stitch of the round (12)
2. K
3. *K1, KFB repeat from * (18)
4. K
5. *K2, KFB repeat from * (24)
6. K
7. *K3, KFB repeat from * (30)
8. K
9. *K4, KFB repeat from * (36)
10. K
11. *K5, KFB repeat from * (42)
12. K
13. *K6, KFB repeat from * (48)
14. - 18. K

18. K (shown on chart for info)

19. Join in Cream/Icing Colour and follow chart carrying colours at back of work until end of round 22 when you can break off the Brown and weave the end in now, the chart is repeated 6 times around.

24. *K4, K2tog repeat from * (40)
24. K
25. *K3, K2tog repeat from * (32)
26. K
27. *K2, K2tog repeat from * (24)
28. K
29. *K1, K2tog repeat from * (16)
30. K
31. *K2tog repeat from * (8)

Break off yarn, leaving a tail to thread through all the stitches

Stuff the bun

Thread the tail end through all the stitches, draw up tight and stitch shut.

Cherry

CO 6 in Red, join in round and spread across two needles or circular needle and cable

1. KFB into all stitches (12)
2. K
3. *K2, KFB repeat from * (16)
4. K
5. *K2tog repeat from * (8)
6. K

Break off yarn leaving tail

Stuff Cherry

Thread yarn tail through all stitches and pull tight, stitch to top of bun and then one stitch through the depth of the bun to flatten out the bottom a touch.

Finishing...

No blocking required.
