

Meshtastic Poncho

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This meshtastic poncho looks great over a sundress or tank top in the summer, or a fitted T in the winter. Very versatile!

Materials:

- medium weight 4 yarn (I used Red Heart Fiesta in Orchid.)
- J or K hook
- yarn needle
- stitch markers for 1st st of each round

Notes:

1. Easy to adjust size by changing hook size and yarn weight! You can continue Round 7 until it reaches your own desired length.
2. Worked completely in the round without turning work.

Stitches Used:

single crochet (sc), half double crochet (hdc),

Instructions:

Ch 95 and slip stitch to form circle.

Round 1: Ch 1. sc in same and in each ch around. Join with sl st to 1st sc. (95)

Rounds 2-3: hdc in same and in each sc around. Join with sl st to 1st hdc. (95)

Round 4: Ch 1. sc in same. *Ch 3, sk 1, sc in next*. Repeat from * to * around, ending with sc. Join with sl st to 1st sc

Round 5: sl st in ch-3 space. Ch 1. sc in same ch-3 space. *Ch 5. sc in next ch-3 space.* Repeat from * to * around, ending with sc. Join with sl st to 1st sc.

Round 6: 2 sl st in ch-5 space. Ch 1. sc in same ch-5 space. *Ch 7, sc in next ch-5 space.* Repeat from * to * around, ending with sc. Join with sl st to 1st sc.

Rounds 7-end: 2 sl st in ch-7 space. Ch 1. sc in same ch-7 space. *Ch 7, sc in next ch-7 space.* Repeat from * to * around, ending with sc. Join with sl st to 1st sc.
