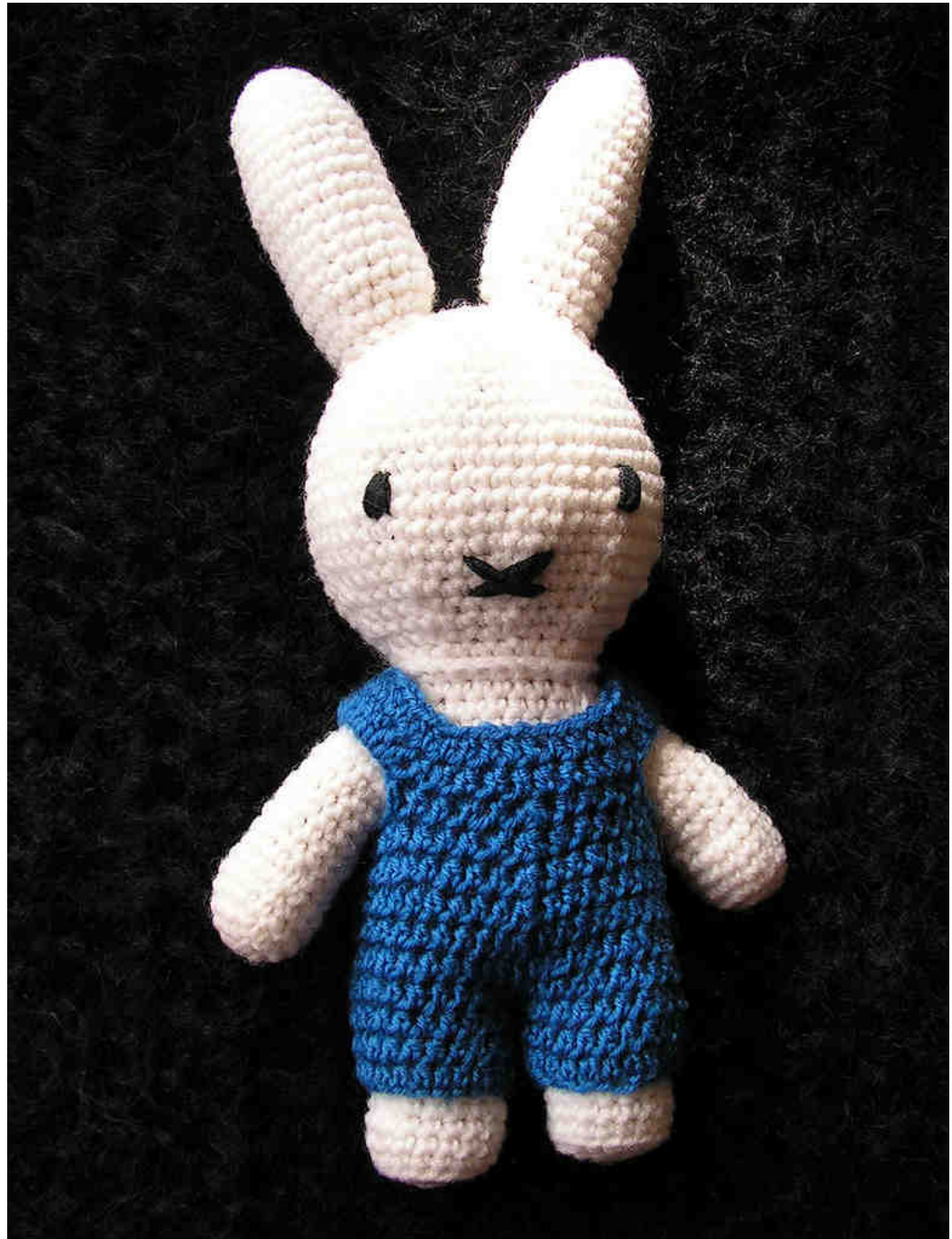


My Miffy bunny

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Materials

- ✓ Light yarn (3 or 4 ply), pure wool super wash or acrylic + wool:
 - one skein white
 - ½ skein blue or desired colour for the dungarees
 - length of black thread to embroider eyes and mouth
- ✓ Old pantyhose cut in little pieces or polyfil for stuffing
- ✓ Crochet hook 2.5 mm for the bunny, 3 mm for the dungarees
- ✓ Embroidery needle

Pattern

All pieces are worked in the round in single crochet. For method and examples, see <http://crochetme.com/amigurumi>

Miffy is begun by the legs.

Legs make 2

Chain 3 and join in round.

Round 1: 6 sc in the round.

Round 2: 2 sc in each sc = 12 sc

Round 3: work in the back loop: [1 sc, 2 sc in next sc] 6 times = 18 sc

Rounds 4 & 5: 1 sc in each sc

Round 6: [5 sc, skip 1 sc] 3 times = 15 sc

Round 7 to 17: 1 sc in each sc.

Stuff and let in stand by.

Body I

Join the two legs with 2 sc, then work on all the stitches, including the two used to join legs, to obtain 30 sc. Work 8 rounds, and let in stand by.

Arms make 2

Chain 3 and join in round.

Round 1: 6 sc in the round.

Round 2: 2 sc in each sc = 12 sc

Round 3: [2 sc, 2 sc in next sc] 4 times = 16 sc

Round 4 to 6: 1 sc in each sc

Round 7: 1 sc, [4 sc, skip 1 sc] 3 times = 13 sc

Round 8 to 11: 1 sc in each sc

Body II

Join each arm to the body with 1 slip stitch, and work on all the stitches = 52 sc

Decrease as for a raglan, skipping 1 sc before and after arm at each round, to obtain 27 sc. Stuff arms and body and let in stand by.

Head

Chain 3 and join in round.

Round 1: 6 sc in the round.

Round 2: 2 sc in each sc = 12 sc

Round 3: [1 sc, 2 sc in next sc] 6 times = 18 sc

Round 4: [1 sc, 2 sc in next sc] 9 times = 27 sc

Round 5: [2 sc, 2 sc in next sc] 9 times = 36 sc

Round 6 to 7: 1 sc in each sc

Round 8: [3 sc, 2 sc in next sc] 9 times = 45 sc

Round 9 to 10: 1 sc in each sc

Round 11: [4 sc, 2 sc in next sc] 9 times = 54 sc

Round 12 to 18: 1 sc in each sc

Round 19: [5 sc, skip 1 sc] 9 times = 45 sc

Round 20: 1 sc in each sc

Round 21: [4 sc, skip 1 sc] 9 times = 36 sc

Round 22: 1 sc in each sc

Round 23: [3 sc, skip 1 sc] 9 times = 27 sc

Round 24: 1 sc in each sc

Stuff the head, and join it to the body with one round of sc. Complete stuff before the end of the round. Fasten off.

Ears make 2

Chain 3 and join in round.

Round 1: 6 sc in the round.

Round 2: 2 sc in each sc = 12 sc

Round 3: 1 sc in each sc

Round 4: [1 sc, 2 sc in next sc] 6 times = 18 sc

Round 5: 1 sc in each sc

Round 6: [5 sc, 2 sc in next sc] 3 times = 21 sc

Round 7 to 16: 1 sc in each sc

Round 17: [6 sc, skip 1 sc] 3 times = 18 sc

Stuff, and sew on the head.

Embroider eyes and mouth.



You can kiss your bunny, because it is adorable.

Dungarees

I've not written down exactly how to make the dungarees, and the number of stitches depend on the yarn you use. It is build in hdc, from bottom-up, making two legs separately, joined as for the legs of the bunny, then worked in the round with one decrease middle front and back at each round. At underarm, skip the number of stitches required to have room for arms, and chain the same number of stitches + 2 or 3 extra stitches above. Work the yoke in the round too.
