

Baby Blankie

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A simple square baby blanket pattern. I used Bernat Soft Boucle and 7mm needles. The main section is worked in garter stitch. Ruffle border has mitered corners and is worked in the round in stockinette stitch with a garter border. Enjoy!

Materials

2 balls (466 mts) Bernat Soft Boucle
7mm needles
7mm circulars 47" length for border
4 stitch markers (1 unique)

Gauge(not crucial)

11 stitches x 22 rows in garter stitch = 4 inches

Measurements

approximately 30" x 30"

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Abbreviations

K = knit

P = purl

SL1 = slip one stitch

PM = place marker

PUM = place unique marker

KFB = knit into front and back of next stitch

SLM = slip marker

Note: when picking up stitches along cast on/off edge, knit into front and back of 62 cast on/off stitches for a total of 124 stitches

Instructions

Main panel:

Cast on 62 stitches.

Row 1: SL1, K to end

Row 2: SL1, K to end

Repeat rows 1 and 2 another 122 times, or until panel is equal in length and width. Cast Off.

Ruffle border:

Pick up and knit 124 stitches along cast off edge (see note), PM,

Pick up and knit 124 stitches along side, PM,

Pick up and knit 124 stitches along cast on edge (see note), PM,

Pick up and knit 124 stitches along side, PUM. This marker will mark the beginning of a new round.

Round 1: *KFB, knit to one stitch before marker, KFB, SLM*, repeat * to * another three times.

Round 2: **K to marker, SLM**, repeat ** to ** another three times.

Repeat Rounds 1 and 2 another 4 times. You have now worked 10 rounds.

Round 11: ***P to marker, SLM***, repeat *** to *** another three times.

Round 12: ****KFB, knit to one stitch before marker, KFB, SLM****, repeat **** to **** another three times.

Repeat Rounds 11 and 12 another 2 times.

Cast Off.
