Jewel Box is a simple, elegant design in a lightweight, all seasons' yarn. Merino / tencel, with its' delicate sheen, makes for a more formal or evening look and the crystal drops add a little weight to the scarf, keeping it in place, even on a breezy evening.

SIZE

One size

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Length: 152 cm / 60 inches

Width: 18cm / 7 inches

MATERIALS

dkKnits Technicolor Gleem Toes, 50% merino / 50% tencel, 450 yds / 2.7 oz,
model shown in: Mermaid Tail

1 4.00mm / G-6 crochet hook

notions required: Beads or crystals of your choice. Model used Swarovski crystals
Beading needle
Thread to match project (if not using project yarn).

GAUGE

Not critical for this project, about 5 motifs every 10cm / 4 inches

PATTERN

Chain 38, or a multiple of 4 + 2 (adding 2 for base chain)

1st row: (right side) In 5th chain from hook, 2dc, 2dc into next chain, *skip 2ch, 2dc into each of next 2ch; repeat from * to last 2ch, skip 1ch, 1dc in last ch, turn.

2nd row: 3ch, *skip 2 sts, 2dc into each of next 2 sts; repeat from * to last 2 sts, skip 1ch, 1dc into tch, turn.

Repeat 2nd row.

Continue in this manner, until your skein is used up or until your scarf is the desired length.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Block lightly, if desired.

Using thread or left-over project yarn, attach your beads or crystals in whatever way looks pleasing to you. The model used 3 different colours of Swarovski crystals, in the barrel shape, alternated. They were attached in every open ch2 space and in the corners.

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
