## **INFINITY COWL**

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## **MATERIALS**

200 yards bulky weight yarn
(sample shown was knit with Misti Alpaca
Chunky Solids 100% Baby Alpaca)
US size 15 (10mm) Double Pointed Needles
(DPNs) or size needed to obtain gauge
Darning needle for weaving ends
Stitch Marker



13 stitches and 11 rows = 4 inches in stockinette stitch, after blocking

Please note that Alpaca grows quite a bit after blocking







## **FINISHED SIZE**

Approximately 25 inches long, 5 inches wide after grafting ends together and blocking

## **INSTRUCTIONS**

Using a provisional cast on, CO 36 stitches. Divide evenly over DPNs and join in the round, being careful not to twist. Mark the beginning of your round with a stitch marker.

Knit in stockinette stitch (knitting every round) untill you are almost out of yarn (remembering to save some for grafting) or until you think you've reached the perfect length.

(Sample shown was about 50 inches long before grafting).

Graft ends together using kitchener stitch.
