

Crochet Jubilee Crown Pattern

Pattern written in UK terms

Yarn:

James C Brett Twinkle Fashion DK (Acrylic) Shade TK8 -
But these would look good in anything with a bit of sparkle.

Hook:

4/4.5mm (UK)

Stitches:

Ch = Chain

SS = Slip Stitch

Htr = Half Treble Crochet (US HDC)

Tr = Treble (US DC)

Foundation Row,

Make the chain long enough to fit around your head
(they will stretch slightly but try to keep it loose) working in
multiples of 3 - I worked 72 Ch for my adult crown.
Join with a ss (try not to twist chain).

Row 1,

Ch 2, Htr in each stitch around, join with a ss.

Row 2,

Ch 2, Htr in each stitch around, join with a ss.

Row 3,

Ch 6, 1 tr in same stitch (to make 1st v stitch), skip next 2 stitches, *(1 tr, ch 3, 1 tr) into next stitch (V stitch), skip next 2 stitches* repeat from *to* around joining with a ss to the 3rd ch of the first ch 6.
Finish off and sew in ends.
