

# -Reusable Cup Sleeves-



Save your hands from hot cups, use up that colorful cotton, and make a few of your very own reusable cup sleeves! The pattern is super easy and gratifying. Use as many colors as you like, or stick to one color. The sleeves are washable and dryable, too, as long as you stick to the delicate setting.

## Abbreviations:

Chain – Ch  
Single crochet – Sc  
Foundation single  
crochet - Fsc

## Materials:

US G/6 4.25mm crochet hook  
Lily Sugar 'n Cream Solids and Stripes, in desired colors  
Yarn needle

## Pattern Note:

All stitches, except top and bottom edging, are worked in back loop only to create a stretchy, ridged pattern.

## Cup Sleeve:

FSC 13, turn.

**Row 1:** Ch 1 (counts as first sc here and throughout), sc in 2nd fsc from hook and in each fsc across, turn.

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in 2nd sc from hook and each sc across, sc in ch 1

Repeat Row 2, 34 times. At the end of Row 36, do not turn.

**Top edging:**

Ch 1, sc in row edge, \*ch 1, skip next row edge, sc in next row edge, repeat from \* across.

Fold sleeve in half width-wise, holding short edges together, sl st through both thicknesses across to join into tube.

**Bottom edging:**

Turn, ch 1, sc in row edge, \*ch 1, skip next row edge, sc in next row edge, repeat from \* across, join with sl st in first sc.

Fasten off.

Weave in all ends.
