

## OWL HAT & BAG



Materials Needed for Owl Hat:

16" 4 mm circular needle  
4 mm double pointed needles  
Worsted Weight Yarn (4) (picture knitted with TLC Lt. Country Rose)  
16 Seed Beads for eyes  
Cable Needle or DPN that can be used as a cable needle  
Tapestry Needle  
Beading Needle

C4B – place two stitches on cable needle and hold at back of work, knit two stitches then knit two stitches from cable needle.

C4F – place two stitches on cable needle and hold at front of work, knit two stitches then knit two stitches from cable needle.

Cast on 92 stitches

Place marker at beginning, join in round.

Roll Brim – Knit 5 rows (stocking stitch)

Flat Brim – Knit 5 rows (Garter Stitch)

Knit 6 rows in 1x1 ribbing

Knit 3 rows stocking stitch

Knit 1 row stocking stitch decrease 4 stitches (88 stitches)

\*K3, P8\* \*rep to end

\*K3, P8\* \*rep to end

Owl Pattern starts:

1. \*P3, K8\* \*rep to end

2. \*P3, K8\* \*rep to end

3. \*P3, C4B, C4F\* \*rep to end

- Owl Pattern ends

Knit 6 rows (stocking stitch)

Shape Crown:

Switch to double pointed needles when needed or can use magic loop method when needed.

1. \*K9, K2tog\* \*rep to end
2. Knit
3. \*K8, K2tog\* \*rep to end
4. Knit
5. \*K7, K2tog\* \*rep to end
6. Knit
7. \*K6, K2tog\* \* rep to end
8. Knit

Continue decreasing in this manner until 8 stitches remain.

Draw thread through pulling tightly to close.

Sew in ends.

Attach beads for eyes on rows 13/14 of Owl Pattern.

## OWL BAG



### Materials Needed:

Worsted weight yarn (4) Picture knitted with Patons Décor (Chocolate Taupe) MC and TLC (Lt. Country Rose) CC  
12" 4 mm circular needle  
Cable needle or dpn to use as a cable needle  
3.25 mm double pointed needle for I cord  
4 mm crochet hook  
12 seed beads for eyes  
Tapestry Needle  
Beading Needle

Cast on 66 stitches using MC yarn  
Join in round.

Knit 11 rows using MC (stocking stitch)  
Purl 1 row

### **Change to CC yarn**

Knit 1 row

Owl Pattern Starts.

1. \*P3, K8\* \*rep to end
2. \*P3, K8\* \*rep to end
3. \*P3, C4B, C4F\* \*rep to end
4. \*P3, K8\* \*rep to end
5. \*P3, K8\* \*rep to end
6. \*P3, K8\* \*rep to end
7. \*P3, K8\* \*rep to end
8. \*P3, K8\* \*rep to end
9. \*P3, K8\* \*rep to end
10. \*P3, K8\* \*rep to end
11. \*P3, C4B, C4F\* \*rep to end
12. \*P3, K8\* \*rep to end
13. \*P3, K1, P2, K2, P2, K1\* \*rep to end

14. \*P3, K1, P2, K2, P2, K1\* \*rep to end
  15. \*P3, K8\* \*rep to end
  16. \*P3, K8\* \*rep to end
  17. \*P3, C4B, C4F\* \*rep to end
  18. \*P3, K8\* \*rep to end
- Owl Pattern Ends.

### **Change to MC**

Knit 1 row  
Purl 1 row  
Knit 10 rows (stocking stitch)

### **Eyelet Row:**

\*K2tog, yo\* \*rep to end  
K 6 rows (stocking stitch)  
P 1 row (fold line)  
K 5 rows  
Cast off.  
Sew cast off edge to the top of the eyelet row.

### **Bag Bottom (12" 4 mm circular)**

Pick up 64 stitches along the 66 st cast on edge, join in round.

P 1 row  
K 1 row

### **Dec as follows:**

\*K6, K2tog\* \* rep to end of round.  
Knit  
\*K5, K2tog\* \*rep to end of round  
Knit

Continue decreasing until 8 stitches remain.  
Draw yarn through the 8 stitches and pull tightly to close the bottom of the bag.

### **Drawstrings**

Make 2 – One in MC and one in CC. Using 3.25 mm dpn cast on 2 sts. Knit until I cord measures 28"

Or Using 4 mm crochet hook – Using 1 strand of MC and CC together chain until it measures 28" approx 125 to 150 chains depending on your tension.

Working from the inside of the purse thread 1 drawstring through eyelets, leaving equal lengths hanging on inside where ends meet. Repeat with the 2<sup>nd</sup> drawstring starting and ending at opposite sides of the bag. Sew the ends of the drawstrings together. Pull ends to close the bag.

Working from the inside of the purse thread the crocheted drawstring through the eyelets, ends hanging on the outside should be equal, sew together. Pull the end to close the bag.
