

Leafy Cloth



*Leafy Cloth is perfect for the summery kitchen.
The leaves brings your mind out out to the green nature,
while washing the dishes.*

Materials:

Yarn: Per Tryving Petunia, about 25 grams

Needles: Circular needle, No. 3,0 mm, 2 x DPN's No 2,5 mm , Tapistery needle.

Size: ca 20 x 20 cm

Abbreviations:

K = Knit P = Purl St(s) = Stitch (es) Yo = Yarn over

SK2tog = Slip one, as if to knit, knit two together, pass slipped st over

Knit the cloth like this:

Cast on loosely 45 sts on circular needle No. 3,0 mm.

Row 1: K (Remember to slip first sts on all rows).

Row 2: K2, P1, K1, P1 till the end of the row.

Row 3: K

Repeat row 1 and 2 until 20 cm. Cast off loosely.

Knit the leaves like this:

Cast on 3 sts on a DPN No. 2,5 mm.

Row 1: Purl

Row 2: K1, Yo, K1, Yo, K1

Row 3: Purl

Row 4: K2, Yo, K1, Yo, K2

Row 5: Purl

Row 6: K3, Yo, K1, Yo, K3

Row 7: Purl

Row 8: K4, Yo, K1, Yo, K4

Row 9: Purl

Row 10: K4, SK2tog, K4

Row 11: Purl

Row 12: K3, SK2tog, K3

Row 13: Purl

Row 14: K2, SK2tog, K2

Row 15: Purl

Row 16: K1, SK2tog, K1

Row 17: Purl

Row 18: SK2tog. Cut the thread and pull through the remaining stich.



Knit second leaf the same way as leaf number one.

Finishing: Fasten the leaves to the cloth with small sewing stitches along the edge of the leaves. Weave in ends. Soak the cloth and lay it out flat while it dries.
