

Super Chunky Hat

This hat is the perfect addition to your winter wardrobe. It only takes a couple of hours to knit, and is super cosy. The chunky yarn knits up quickly and easily on big needles, so you can make a hat as a last minute gift, or knit yourself several in different colours.



Materials needed

Cygnet Seriously Chunky – 1 ball, or approx. 45m of super chunky yarn.

12mm needles

Yarn needle for sewing in ends

Abbreviations

Dec	Decrease
K	Knit
K2tog	Knit two together
P	Purl
P2tog	Purl two together
Rep	Repeat
St	Stitch
St st	Stocking stitch
WS	Wrong side

Gauge

8 sts x 10 rows to 10cm/4in over pattern on 12mm needles

Size

Small – to fit head size 53-58.5cm/21-23in

Large – to fit head size 56-61cm/22-24in

To make the hat longer for more of a beanie style, add more rows of stocking stitch. You may need more than one ball of yarn.

Instructions

Cast on 42 (46) sts.

Row 1: *K2, p2, rep from * to last 2 sts, k2.

Row 2: *P2, k2, rep from * to last 2 sts, p2.

Rep these two rows once more.

Work 10 rows st st, ending with a WS row.

Dec for top of hat as follows:

Row 1: *K3, k2tog, rep from * to last 2 (1) sts, k2 (1). (36, 37) sts

Row 2: P to end.

Row 3: *K2, k2tog, rep from * to last 0 (1) sts, k0 (1). (27, 28) sts

Row 4: P to end.

Row 5: *K1, k2tog, rep from * to last 0 (1) sts, k0 (1). (18, 19) sts

Row 6: P to end.

Row 7: *K2tog, rep from * to last 0 (1) sts, k0 (1). (9, 10) sts

Row 8: P2tog to last 1 (0) sts, p1 (0). (5sts)

Break yarn, thread through remaining sts and draw up tightly to finish. Sew side seam.
