

Chunky Woven Scarf

This chunky scarf is knitted in a basketweave pattern, and can be made in two different widths. Adjusting the length is easily done by adding more pattern repeats, and the woven effect is unisex. The scarf will knit up in a couple of hours, making it perfect for last minute gifts.

Materials needed

Cygnets Seriously Chunky – 2 balls for skinny scarf and 3 balls for chunky, or approx. 100-140m of super chunky yarn.

12mm needles
Yarn needle for sewing in ends

Abbreviations

K	Knit
P	Purl
Rep	Repeat
St	Stitch

Gauge

8 sts x 10 rows to 10cm/4in
over pattern on 12mm
needles

Size

Skinny size – approx. 12.5cm/5in wide, length adjustable
Chunky size – approx. 16.5cm/6.5in wide, length adjustable



Instructions

Cast on 10 (14) sts using 12mm needles.

Row 1: *K2, p2, rep from * to end of row.

Row 2: *P2, k2, rep from * to end of row.

Rows 3 & 4: Rep Rows 1 & 2.

Row 5: *P2, k2, rep from * to end of row.

Row 6: *K2, p2, rep from * to end of row.

Rows 7 & 8: Rep Rows 5 & 6.

These 8 rows form pattern. Continue in pattern until yarn runs out, or until scarf reaches desired length, preferably finishing on Row 4 or 8 of pattern.

Cast off in pattern and sew in ends.
