

Island Yarn

Parfait Shawlette

Cashmere Parfait



SUPPLIES

- *1 Hank Island Yarn Cashmere Parfait
- *Size 7 (4.5 mm) Circular Needle, 24"+
- *Darning needles for weaving in ends

GAUGE

Unimportant

FINISHED SIZE

Approx 12"deep x 72" long

ABBREVIATIONS

- K = Knit
- YO = yarn over
- VDD = Vertical Double Decrease – slip 2 stitches knitwise at the same time, k1, pass the 2 slipped stitches over
- K2tog – Knit 2 together
- PM = place marker
- SM = slip marker
- CO = cast on
- BO = bind off

PATTERN NOTES

This shawllette is worked from the tip up. You can choose to stop whenever you like, but if you use the whole skein (as recommended) BO when you have about 5 yards of yarn left. BO is best worked on row 8, but can easily be done on any even row.

INSTRUCTIONS

CO 5 sts.

Row 1: K2, pm, YO, K1, YO, K2

Row 2, 4, 8, 10: CO3, K to end

Row 3, 5, 7: CO3, K to marker, sm, YO, VDD, YO, K to end

Row 6: CO3, Knit these 3 CO stitches, K1, P to last 4, K4

Row 9*: CO 3, K4, (yo, K2tog) to marker, sm, YO, VDD, YO, (K2tog, YO) to last 4, K4

Repeat Rows 1-10 until desired size keeping marker at the center stitch. *On alternate repeats of row 9 work as follows - CO 3, K4, (yo, K2tog) to 1 before marker, K1, sm, YO, VDD, YO, K1, (K2tog, YO) to last 4, K4 to account for the extra stitch.

BO all sts loosely and weave in ends. Block lightly if desired.
