

Crochet Pattern

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**Skill level:** Advanced beginner

**Supplies needed:**

Fingering weight yarn (ex. Sandnes Garn Mandarin Petit or Patons Grace)

Crochet Hook D (3.25 mm)

Yarn needle

**Finished size:**

Big flower 4"

Small flower 3"

**Abbreviations and stitches used:**

- Ch – chain
- Rnd – round
- Sc – single crochet
- Sl st – slip stitch

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**1.** Ch 2  
**Row 1:** 2 sc in 2nd ch from hook. (2 sc)



**2. Row 2:** Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in ea sc. (4 sc)



**3. Row 3:** Ch 1, turn, sc in ea sc. (4 sc)



**4. Row 4:** Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in 1st sc, sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in last sc. (6 sc)



**5. Row 5:** Ch 1, turn, sc in ea sc. (6 sc)

**Row 6:** Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in 1st sc, sc in next 4 sc, 2 sc in last sc. (8 sc)

**Row 7:** Ch 1, turn, sc in ea sc. (8 sc)

**Row 8:** Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in 1st sc, sc in next 6 sc, 2 sc in last sc. (10 sc)

**Row 9:** Ch 1, turn, sc in 9 sc, 3 sc in last sc. (12 sc)



**6.** Do not turn your work. Sc across the side of petal. 3 sc in top of petal. Sc across another side until you reach 1st sc of row 9.



**7.** Make sl st into 1st sc of rnd 9. Fasten off. Make 6 petals. Leave long yarn end in one of the petals.



**8.** Flower middle:  
**Rnd 1:** 10 sc into magic loop. Join with sl st.



**9. Rnd 2:** Ch 1, [sc in next c, 2 sc in next sc] 5 times. Join with sl st.  
**Rnd 3-5:** Ch 1, sc in ea sc. Join with sl st. Fasten off.



**13.** Putting flower together:  
With yarn needle start sewing the bottom of the petal that has long yarn end.



**14.** Connect all petals in same manner. Tighten yarn to bring petals close. Sew on the middle of the flower.



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### Big Flower Pattern:

Ch 2

**Row 1:** 2 sc in 2nd ch from hook. (2 sc)

**Row 2:** Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in ea sc. (4 sc)

**Row 3:** Ch 1, turn, sc in ea sc. (4 sc)

**Row 4:** Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in 1st sc, sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in last sc. (6 sc)

**Row 5:** Ch 1, turn, sc in ea sc. (6 sc)

**Row 6:** Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in 1st sc, sc in next 4 sc, 2 sc in last sc. (8 sc)

**Row 7:** Ch 1, turn, sc in ea sc. (8 sc)

**Row 8:** Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in 1st sc, sc in next 6 sc, 2 sc in last sc. (10 sc)

**Row 9:** Ch 1, turn, sc in 9 sc, 3 sc in last sc. (12 sc)

Do not turn your work. Sc across the side of petal. 3 sc in top of petal. Sc across another side until you reach 1st sc of row 9.

Make sl st into 1st sc of rnd 9. Fasten off.

Make 6 petals. Leave long yarn end in one of the petals.

#### Flower middle:

**Rnd 1:** 10 sc into magic loop. Join with sl st.

**Rnd 2:** Ch 1, [sc in next c, 2 sc in next sc] 5 times. Join with sl st.

**Rnd 3-5:** Ch 1, sc in ea sc. Join with sl st. Fasten off.

#### Putting flower together:

With yarn needle start sewing the bottom of the petal that has long yarn end. Connect all petals in same manner. Tighten yarn to bring petals close. Sew on the middle of the flower. Fasten off. Weave in all ends.

### Small Flower Pattern:

Ch 2

**Row 1:** 2 sc in 2nd ch from hook. (2 sc)

**Row 2:** Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in ea sc. (4 sc)

**Row 3-4:** Ch 1, turn, sc in ea sc. (4 sc)

**Row 5:** Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in 1st sc, sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in last sc. (6 sc)

**Row 6:** Ch 1, turn, sc in ea sc. (6 sc)

**Row 7:** Ch 1, turn, sc in 5 sc, 3 sc in last sc. (8 sc)

Do not turn your work. Sc across the side of petal. 3 sc in top of petal. Sc across another side until you reach 1st sc of row 7.

Make sl st into 1st sc of rnd 7. Fasten off.

Make 6 petals. Leave long yarn end in one of the petals.

#### Flower middle:

**Rnd 1:** 8 sc into magic loop. Join with sl st.

**Rnd 2:** Ch 1, [sc in next c, 2 sc in next sc] 4 times. Join with sl st.

**Rnd 3-4:** Ch 1, sc in ea sc. Join with sl st. Fasten off.

#### Putting flower together:

With yarn needle start sewing the bottom of the petal that has long yarn end. Connect all petals in same manner. Tighten yarn to bring petals close. Sew on the middle of the flower. Fasten off. Weave in all ends.
