

Materials & Sizes

- Sizes** One size, but extensive instructions and stitch counts for larger or smaller versions are included.
Lace: 133 cm x 39 cm (approx. 52" x 15"); after blocking.
Fingering: 155 cm x 49 cm (approx. 61" x 19"); after blocking.
- Yarn** Lace or fingering weight, approx. 402 m/440 yd
If you are using fingering weight yarn, please be aware that you will be cutting it close with only one 100 gram skein. If you can, make sure to have some extra on hand, or use a 4mm/US 6 needle to work the shawl at a slightly smaller gauge.
- Needles** 4,5 mm/US 7 80cm/32" circular needle, or size needed to get gauge.
- Notions** Two stitch markers; tapestry needle
- Gauge** **Lace:** 22 sts/33 rows to 10 cm/4"
Fingering: 19 sts/29 rows to 10 cm/4"
in stockinette stitch on 4,5 mm/US 7 needles (after blocking)
- Gauge is not crucial for this project, but a different gauge will affect the amount of yarn you need and the finished size of the shawl.

- Yarn** Lace weight or Fingering weight, approx. 402 m/440 yd
Has been knit in: (Not all versions are shown here)
Lace : Lace by Malabrigo Yarn; 430 m/ 470 yd per 50 g;
1 skein; colour 7: Cadmium.
Lace: Cashmere 1 by Artyarns; 466 m/510 yd per 50 g;
1 skein; colour 2229.
Fingering: Sock by Malabrigo Yarn; 402 m/440 yd per 100 g;
1 skein; colour 808: Violeta Africana

Difficulty Intermediate



Pattern information

Marjorie is a shallow shawl that is perfect for that precious single skein of sock yarn. The solid stockinette body beautifully shows off subtle colour variations and the lace edging gives it an airy and pretty touch.

The explanation of all symbols and abbreviations can be found on the next page.

Making the shawl smaller or larger

The table below shows the rows and stitch counts that allow you to work full repeats of the edging pattern.

Note: If you're working at a smaller or larger gauge than the one stated in the beginning of the pattern, you will respectively use less or more yarn to knit the same number of stitches. To make sure that you will be able to complete your shawl, please weigh your yarn before starting and at various points during your knitting. This will help you estimate more accurately when to start the edging.

Instructions

Set up

Cast on 2 sts; k 6 rows.

Turn the strip 90° and pick up and knit 3 sts along the edge.

(One for each garter bump)

Turn the strip another 90° and pick up 2 sts from the cast on edge.

7 sts on needle.

Row 0: k2, p2, place marker, p1, k2.

Body of shawl

Row 1: k2, m1L, k to m, m1R, slm, k1, m1L, k last 2 sts, m1R, k2.

Row 2: k2, m1L, p to last 2 sts, m1R, k2.

Repeat these rows another 34 times (217 sts on your needle).

To make a shawl smaller or larger than shown, please refer to the stitch counts & percentages table.

Work the edging pattern from the chart or the written instructions. Work row 2 and all following WS rows as follows:

Row 2: k2, p to last 2 sts, k2.

After completing the entire lace edging (ending with WS row 48) bind off loosely as follows:

Bind off: k2, *slip sts back on left needle, k2togtbl, k1*

Repeat until there is only one stitch left. Break yarn and pull through the loop. Block your shawl, weave in your ends and wear it with pride.
