

Sunny Headband

Please Note:

“American” terms are used throughout.

These patterns are copyrighted, so please don't pass them around. You can, however, sell any crochet you make using these patterns for charity or personal profit.

I do my best to avoid mistakes in the patterns, but accidents happen. If you do catch an error, or if something just isn't clear enough, please contact me at yarnflight.com.

Difficulty Rating: Easy

Yarn: Bernat Premium, 1 ball, shown in Gold

Sizing: 53 cm (21”) circumference, 14.5cm (5.75”) wide

Hook Size: 5.5mm (I-9)

Notions: Yarn needle

Gauge: 5cm (2”) = 7 stitches and 7 rows

**Notes**

- You can make this any circumference you like, just stop working on the band 2.5cm (1”) less than you want the final circumference to be.
- The second pleat is done in the opposite direction of the first, read the pattern carefully

Special Stitches

Pleat: See photos at the end of the pattern.

Pattern

Ch 22

Row 1: Sc in 4th ch from the hook, * ch 1, skip next stitch, sc. Repeat from * across (10 sc) ch 2, turn.

Row 2: Sc in next ch space, * Ch 1, sc in next ch space. Repeat from * across (10 sc) ch 2, turn.

Repeat row 2 until the band reaches approx. 51cm (20") or desired length.

Pleat Row: Sc in 1st 2 st, insert hook into next st from front to back, skip 2 st, insert hook into next st from back to front, skip 2 st, insert hook into next st from front to back, yo, draw yarn through all 3 st (2 loops on hood), yo, draw through remaining 2 loops (1 pleat made), 2 sc, insert hook into next st from back to front, skip 2 st, insert hook into next st from front to back, skip 2 st, insert hook into next st from back to front, yo, draw yarn through all 3 st (2 loops on hood), yo, draw through remaining 2 loops (1 pleat made), (8 st) ch 1, turn.

Final Row: Sc in each st. (8 st)

Fasten off.

Other end: Join yarn to bottom corner of 1st row. Repeat Pleat Row and Final Row. Fasten off leaving an 20cm (8") tail.

Block if necessary.

With wrong sides facing up, sew ends together. Weave in ends.



Insert hook into next stitch from front to back.



Skip 2 stitches, insert hook in next stitch from back to front.



Skip 2 stitches, insert hook from front to back.



Yarn over, draw yarn through all 3 stitches, 2 loops on hook.
