

# Double Fan Stitch Prayer Shawl

or

## Lap Afghan

**NOTE:** To alter the pattern you can use more or less pattern repeats. The pattern I have written here uses 10 pattern repeats and measures about 30" (75cm) wide. So, 15 pattern repeats would be about 45" (112.5cm) wide.

**FOR A LAP AFGHAN:** You could use the same guide lines set here or use a larger hook, such as a K/6.5mm or L/8.00mm and two strands of yarn held together as one for a nice thick blanket. Gauge with change from what is stated here in the pattern guide lines if you change hook and yarn though.

### **Pattern Repeat - chain multiples of 9 sts + 3 (at end for turning chain)**

#### ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain  
ch-space = space previously made  
dc = double crochet  
rep = repeat  
st(s) = stitch(es)  
sk = skip



**HOOK:** J/6.00mm

**YARN:** Any worsted weight yarn. Please note your chosen yarn's care instructions.

**SIZE:** About 30" X 70" (75cm X 175cm)

**GAUGE:** not critical for this pattern but we are looking for about 3" (7.5cm) per pattern repeat and 2" (5cm) for three rows.

#### PATTERN

ch 93

**ROW 1:** Work 2 dc in 5<sup>th</sup> ch from hook, ch 1, 2 dc in next ch, sk next 3 ch, (dc, ch 2, dc) in next ch, \*sk next 3 ch, 2 dc in next ch, ch 1, 2 dc in next ch, sk next 3 ch, (dc, ch 2, dc) in next ch; rep from \* across until 2 chs remain, sk first ch, dc in last ch.

**ROW 2:** Ch 3, turn, sk first st, \*(2 dc, ch 1, 2 dc) in next ch-2 space, (dc, ch 2, dc) in next ch-1 space; rep from \* across, end by working a dc in the top of the turning ch.

Repeat row 2 until piece measures about 70" (175cm) from beginning. This will be about 105 rows.

Fasten off.

Add trim and/or tassels if desired.
