

Mr. Tumnus Scarf



Ever since I saw the movie *The Lion, The Witch, and The Wardrobe*, I've wanted to make the Mr. Tumnus scarf. To my great disappointment, there didn't seem to be a pattern for it.

Fast forward five years. While in New Zealand, I found it. The yarn. The perfect yarn for the Mr. Tumnus scarf. I'm fairly certain there was a beam of light shining down on the skein.

After a bit of fiddling, and buying several new pairs of needles, I was able to recreate the scarf. It is a quick and completely reversible knit. Enjoy.

Sizing and Materials

Size	One Size Fits All
Finished Measurements	80 inch/ 203cm length 5 inch/ 12.7 width
Yarn	One skein of Touch Yarns Brushed Solid (Merino/Mohair) 241 yards/ 220 meters in Color way 101 If substituting yarn, I highly recommend using a Mohair or Mohair blend yarn with lots of halo.
Needles	size 15 (10.0 mm)
Gauge	Not critical. 15sts = 5inches/ 12.7cm

Pattern

With the size 15 (10.0mm) needles, cast on 15 stitches with both ends of the yarn.
All rows: [k2, p2] until there are three stitches left.
Then k2, p1
Knit until yarn runs out or desired length is achieved.
Weave in ends.
