

Easter Marshmallow Bunnies

Materials: (for one bunny):

12 yards Worsted Weight Yarn (I used Red Heart Acrylic)
3 Beads
Fiberfill
Size G (4.25mm) Crochet Hook
Black Sewing Thread
Sewing Needle
Yarn Needle

Stitches Used/Abbreviations:

ch = chain
sl st = slip stitch
sc = single crochet
hdc = half double crochet
dc = double crochet
st = stitch
beg = beginning

Finished Size: 4" tall x 1 ¾" wide

Marshmallow Bunny (make two):

Bunny Body:

Round 1) Ch 8, 2 sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next 5 ch sts, 3 sc in last ch st. Turn and work along the other side of the ch 8 (see photo 1), sc in the next 5 ch sts, sc in same st as the beg 2 sc, join with a sl st to beg sc. Do Not Turn. (16 sc)



Round 2) ch 1, 2 sc in same st, 2 dc in next st, (dc, sc) in next st, sl st in next st, dc in next st, 2 dc in each of the next 2 sts, hdc in next st, 2 sc in next st, hdc in next st, 2 dc in each of the next 2 sts, dc in next st, sl st in next st, (sc, dc) in next st, 2 dc in last st. Join with a sl st to beg sc. (26 sts around) Do not turn. Do not end off, continue on to ear instructions that follow.



End of round 2 should look like this

Ears) ch 6, hdc in 2nd ch from hook, dc in next 4 ch sts (see photo #1), sl st in same st as the beg ch 6 (see photo #2)(first ear made), sl st in next st, ch 6, hdc in 2nd ch from hook, dc in next 4 ch sts, sl st in same st as the ch 6,(2nd ear made)(see photo #3). End off, leaving a long tail at the end of one of the pieces to be used later when stitching pieces together. Weave in all other ends.



Eyes and Nose:

Use black sewing thread and needle and stitch beads onto face.

Assembly:

Place both pieces together, with wrong sides facing each other. Use long tail left at the end of one of the pieces, and whip stitch the pieces together, stuffing with fiberfill as you go. (Note: I only stuffed the body section with fiberfill, and did not stuff the ears.)

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
