The Waverly Scarf is made with Loops & Thread Charisma Tweed 廭 5 🦠



Skill level: Easy

Needed: hook size 12mm (O), Two colours are needed – I used 2 skeins of honey (colour A) and 1 skein of cream (colour B)



Starting with Colour A

Ch. 16

Row 1: sc in each stitch across (15 sc)

Row 2: ch 3, dc in same st, dc, dc3tog, dc, dc, dc, dc, dc, dc3tog, dc, 2 dc

Row 3: ch 3, dc in same st, dc, dc3tog, dc, dc, dc, dc, dc, dc3tog, dc, 2 dc in top of ch3

Row 4 - 10: rep row 3

Row 11-12: Colour B - rep row 3

Row 13-16: Colour A - rep row 3

Row 17-22: Colour B - rep row 3

Row 23-26: Colour A - rep row 3

Row 27-28: Colour B - rep row 3

Row 29-37: Colour A - rep row 3

Row 38-43: Colour B - rep row 3

Row 44-46: Colour A - rep row 3

Row 47-52: Colour B - rep row 3

Row 53-60: Colour A - rep row 3

Row 61-64: Colour B - rep row 3

Row 65-70: Colour A - rep row 3

Row 70: ch 1, sc in same st, sc, sc3tog, sc, sc, 3 sc, sc, sc3tog, sc, sc. Finish off.

Finished size: 7.5" x 71"

Finishing

Tassels – 12" strands

Colour A – 32 strands

Colour B – 16 strands

Attach tassels evenly 8 on each end using three strands 2 of colour A and 1 of colour B.

Index:

st: stitch rep: repeat sc: single crochet dc: double crochet

dc3tog: double crochet 3 together sc3tog: single crochet 3 together
