Colour Cowl

Skill level: Super Easy



This cowl, or neck warmer is super easy to knit and great to wear. It is knitted as a straight scarf and the short end is stitched on to the long end. The cowl is a perfect way to show off your hand spun and hand dyed yarn or art yarn!

Material

Yarn: 100g/4 ounces single ply yarn

(approx 330 yards)

Weight : 12 WPI - Worsted Weight

Knitting needles: size 5,5 mm / US 9

Darning needle

The yarn used in the model is form On The Round at Etsy: ontheround.etsy.com

Abbreviations

K Knit

P Purl

St/s Stitch/es

Make the Colour Cowl

Cast on 60 sts and work in rib (k2, p2) until you have about 2 meters/80" yarn left. Bind off loosely and weave in loose ends. Stitch the bind off end to the long side of the scarf, starting at the corner. Stretch the short end a bit as you stitch it to the scarf to form the cowl. The more you stretch the tighter it will be around the neck.

Enjoy your knitted cowl!



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
