



Wicked Easy Scarf

An easy beginner scarf pattern. Uses worsted weight yarn.



Pattern Info:

Gauge: 4.5 sts = 1" / 2.5 cm in 1x1 rib

Yarn: 400 yds of worsted weight yarn, shown in Merino Worsted by Malabrigo (100% Merino; 100 g = 210 yards), 2 skeins

Needles and other supplies:

- Size US 7 / 4.5 mm or size needed to obtain gauge
- Tapestry needle or crochet hook to weave in ends

Notes:

Wicked Easy Scarf is a simple beginner project. Gauge is not vital but you should stick with using a worsted weight yarn and using the needle size recommended on the yarn label.

Abbreviations:

CO = cast on st(s) = stitch(es)
k = knit p = purl
BO = bind off

Pattern stitches:

- **1x1 Rib:** *k1,p1; repeat from * to end.

Pattern Instructions:

- CO 24 sts
- Work in 1x1 rib until measures 80" / 203 cm from CO edge, or desired length
- BO in pattern

Helpful Hint: In order to have a nice neat edge, some people slip the 1st st of every rw. Another tip that I used for this project: k the 1st st, put the needle into the 2nd st and give it a good tug. Then work the 2nd st. Do the same to the 3rd st. Tugging the 2nd and 3rd st before you work it, I have found, keeps your edge looking tidy.
