

## Fingerless mittens with cables



One set of double pointed needles 2,5 mm

Sockyarn - I used about 30 gr of Opal Uni Solid 4 ply

Gauge: 16 sts stockinette = 5 cm

Abbreviations: Knitty' s standard [www.knitty.com](http://www.knitty.com)

### Comments

The mittens are knitted in the round from a chartered pattern. The charts are showing all rows.

Take special notice so you don't drop the YO's in the beginning and end of the needle with the cable pattern.

Knit the rib on rows 1-19 with at twisted knit-stitch; [K1tbl, P1].

### Left mitten

CO 61 st and divide them on three dpns; needle # 1 = 31 sts, # 2= 15 sts, # 3=15 sts.

Join and begin working in the round, be careful not to twist the CO sts. Begin knitting from the bottom right of the chart; needle 1 and row 1.

Follow the chart for Left Mitten from row 1 to 73;

Row **23**, **27**, **31**, **35**, **39**, **43** and **47**: inc for thumb as marked in the chart.

Row **50**: place 16 sts on waste yarn.

Row **51**: CO 7 sts behind the sts on the waste yarn – on needle # 3 = 13 sts.

Row **65**: dec 1 st at the end of needle # 3 = 12 sts (left mitt) or needle # 1 (right mitt)

Row 73: BO loosely (try a larger needle).

### Thumb

Place the 16 sts from the waste yarn on a needle. Pick up 9 sts from the CO above = 25 sts.

Divide on three needles and knit in the round for about 8 rows. Knit 5 rows of rib; [K1tbl, P1]. BO loosely.

### Right mitten

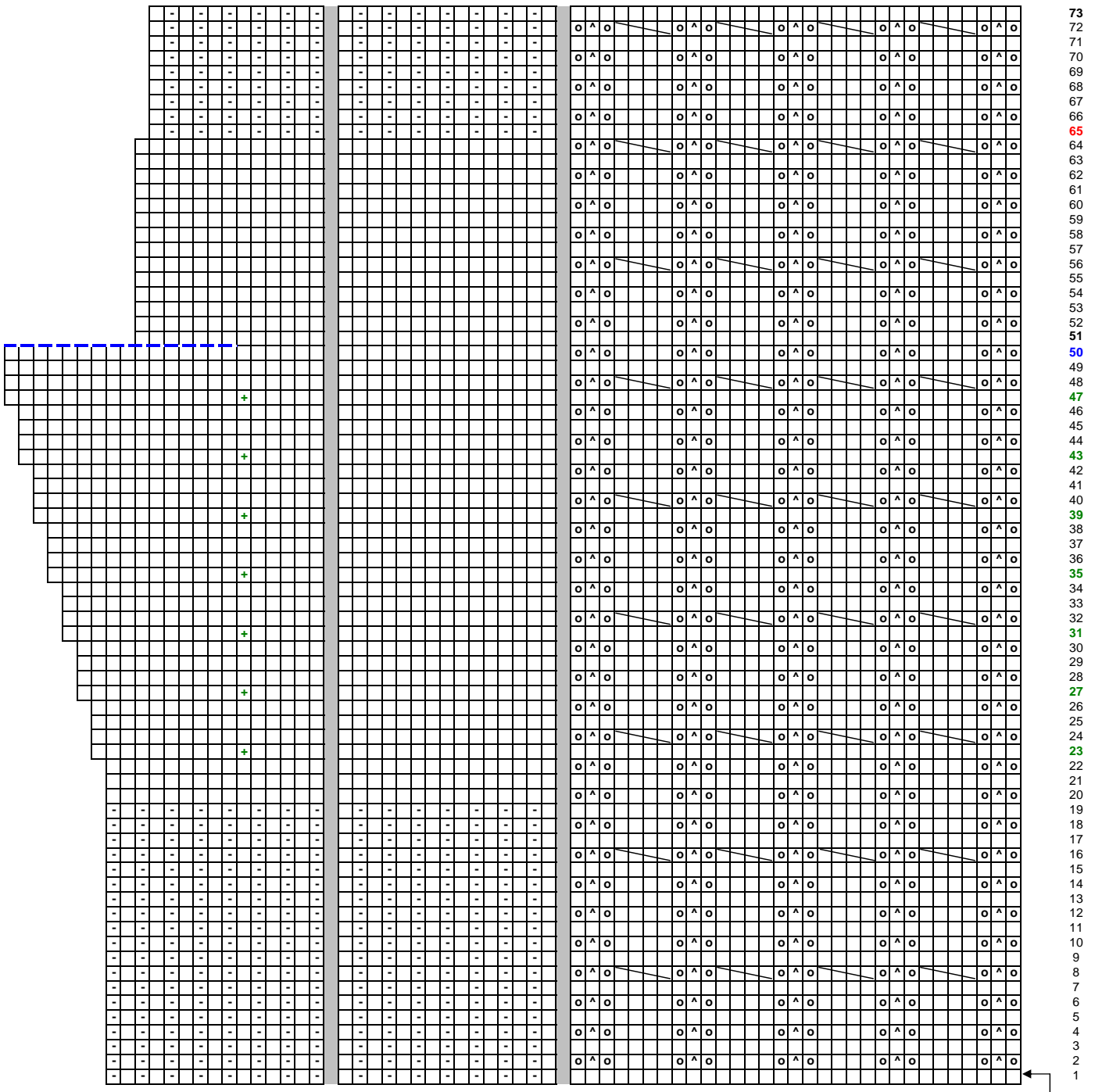
CO 61 sts and follow the chart for Right mitten.

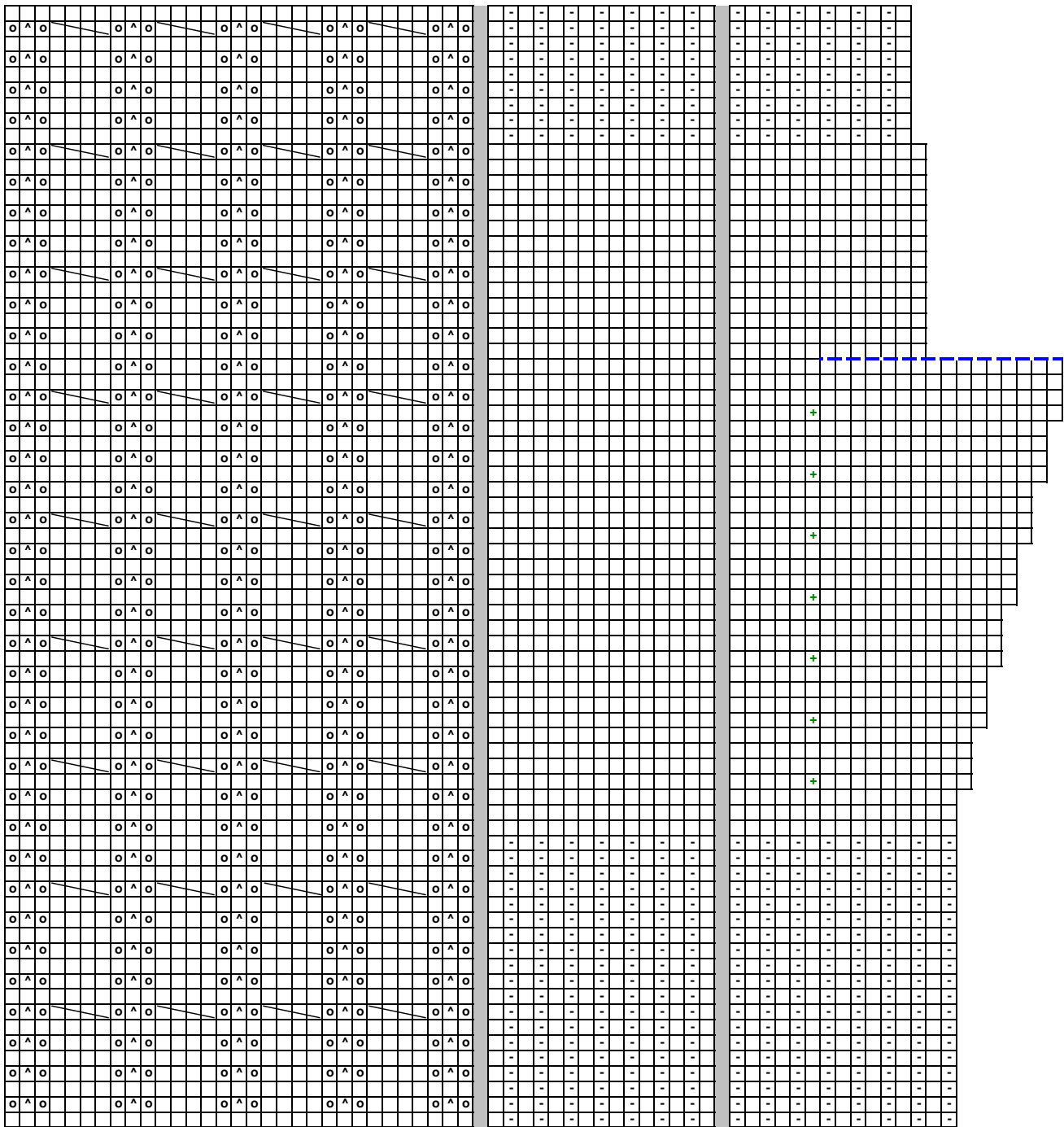
Needle 1

Start here!

CHART KEY

-  Knit
-  Purl
-  Yarn over
-  Slip 2 sts as if to knit them together, K1, pass slipped stitches over
-  Put 2 sts on a cable needle in front of work, K2, K2 from cable needle
-  Lift thread running between stitches, place it on left needle, knit it through back loop = 1 stitch increased
-  Put 16 sts on waste yarn
-  No stitch

**RIGHT MITTEN**











**CHART KEY**

-  Knit
-  Purl
-  Yarn over
-  Slip 2 sts as if to knit them together, K1, pass slipped stitches over
-  Put 2 sts on a cable needle in front of work, K2, K2 from cable needle
-  Lift thread running between stitches, place it on left needle, knit it through back loop = 1 stitch increased
-  Put 16 sts on waste yarn
-  No stitch
