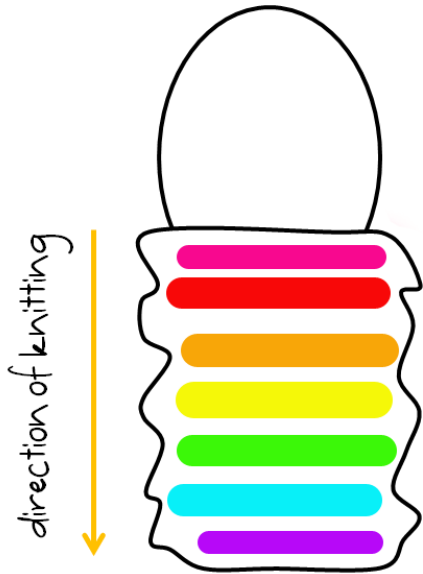


# Either Way Cowl

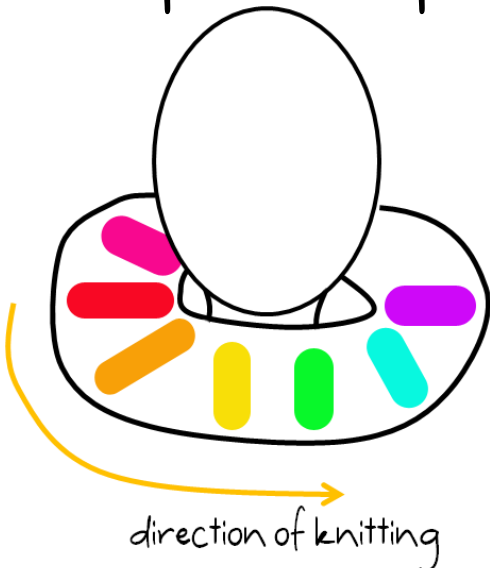


Two ways. Both simple. Both amazing.



Easiest Way

Try this way!



Cast on 100 stitches. Join to work in round.

Round 1: Knit all stitches.

Round 2: Purl all stitches.

Repeat rounds 1-2 two more times.

Repeat round 1 until 15 yards of yarn remain.

Repeat rounds 1-2 three times.

Bind off. Weave in ends.

You'll need:

- 2 skeins Shepherd's Wool Crazy
- 16" circular needle, size 8 (5.0mm)
- Tapestry needle

Gauge: 5 sts/inch (stockinette)

Use provisional cast on to cast on 100 stitches.

Join to work in round.

Knit all stitches until 4 yards of yarn remain.

Kitchener first and last rounds together.\*

Weave in end.

\* Use a spare needle to hold stitches
