## C'Mon Baby (Twist and Slouch)

Materials: Size US 6 Circular Needle

Size US 8 Circular Needle

Set of Size US 8 DPN's

Tapestry/Yarn Needle

Yarn: 1 Skein (100g/219yd) Cascade Yarns  
Alpaca Lana D'Oro

Gauge: 4.5 sts/inch and 6 rows/inch on US 8

Size: to fit 21"-22" head

CO 110 sts using smaller (6) needles.

Join and begin knitting in the round. Work 7 rows k1, p1 ribbing

Change to larger (8) needles, work pattern set up row: \*k4, p7\*10 times

In each row, the pattern repeat will be worked 10 times. Work rows 1-22 of the pattern twice, then begin decreases at row 45. You can EITHER use the charted or written instructions.

Pattern repeat:

1: yo, k3, ssk, p6

2: p1, k4, p6

3: p1, yo, k3, ssk, p5

4: p2, k4, p5

5: p2, yo, k3, ssk, p4

6: p3, k4, p4

7: p3, yo, k3, ssk, p3

8: p4, k4, p3

9: p4, yo, k3, ssk, p2

10: p5, k4, p2

11: p5, yo, k3, ssk, p1

12: p6, k4, p1

13: p6, yo, k3, ssk

14: p7, k4. **Stop 1 stitch before the end of rows 14, 16, 18, 20, and 22. The one stitch remaining is now the first stitch of the next row. Therefore, you are now beginning the next row.**

15: ssk, p6, yo, k3

16: k1, p7, k3

17: k1, ssk, p6, yo, k2

18: k2, p7, k2

19: k2, ssk, p6, yo, k1

20: k3, p7, k1

21: k3, ssk, p6, yo

22: k4, p7

45: yo, k3, k3togtbl, p5

46: p1, k4, p5

47: p1, yo, k3, k3togtbl, p3

48: p2, k4, p3

49: p2, yo, k3, k3togtbl, p1

50: p3, k4, p1. **The last stitch of row 50 becomes the first stitch of row 51.**

51: k3togtbl, p3, yo, k3

52: k1, p3, k3.

53: k3togtbl, p1, yo, k3

54: k1, p2, k3

55: k3togtbl, p1, k3

56: k1, p1, k3

57: ssk, k3

58: knit

59: ssk, k2

60: ssk, k1

61: ssk

Cut yarn, leaving a 6" tail. Thread remaining live stitches onto yarn using tapestry needle. Sew in ends and block lightly to allow yarn to bloom and lace to open.

Stop 1 stitch before the end of rows 14, 16, 18, 20, and 22. The one stitch remaining is now the first stitch of the next row. Therefore, you are now beginning the next row.
