



Alpine Stitch Scarf

Alpine stitch is a really nice alternative to rib or moss stitch to give a double sided finish – it's kind of a mix of the two stitches

Size

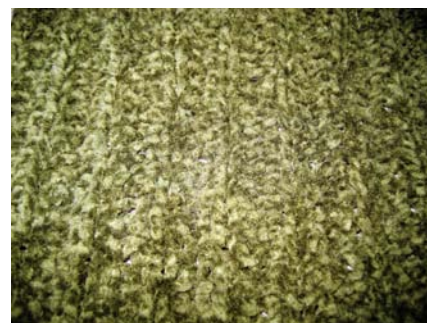
One size. Length 175 cm (adjust as you wish)

Materials

Rowan Chunky Chenille
4-5 mm needles

Tension

14-16sts x 23-24 rows = 10cm in stitch pattern



ALPINE STITCH PATTERN

Multiple of 4 + 3 extra

Row 1: *K2, P2; repeat from * ending K2, P1

Repeat this row

SCARF PATTERN

Loosely cast on 39 sts

Slipping the first stitch of each row knit-wise, work in Alpine stitch pattern for 175cm or however long you wish
Cast off loosely.

FINISHING

Trim with tassels made from remainder of yarn.

Gently handwash scarf.

Block and allow to dry flat.
