

Transatlantic Crochet

Tide Mouse



Materials

- 3.5 mm hook
- Brown, white and pink/beige sport weight yarn
- Toy stuffing
- Yarn needle

Stitches

- Chain (ch)
- Magic ring (MR)
- Slip stitch
- Single crochet (sc)
- Single crochet increase (inc)
- Single crochet decrease (dec)

Instructions

Body

With brown yarn:

Round 1: 6 sc in MR (6)

Round 2: inc around (12)

Round 3: (sc, inc) around (18)

Round 4: (2 sc, inc) around (24)

Round 5: (3 sc, inc) around (30)

Round 6: (4 sc, inc) around (36)

Rounds 7-23: sc around (36)

Round 24: (4 sc, dec) around (30)

Round 25: sc around (30)

Round 26: (4 sc, inc) around (36)

Round 27: sc around (36)



Round 28: (4 sc, dec) around (30)

Round 29: (3 sc, dec) around (24)

Begin stuffing the body. Stuff as you go from now on.

The following “rounds” are not complete rounds and will not end and begin in the same place – however, the provided stitch count is still the total number of stitches of the round:

Round 30: (5 sc, dec) x3 (21)

Round 31: (4 sc, dec) x3 (18)

Round 32: (3 sc, dec) x3 (15)

Round 33: (2 sc, dec) x3 (12)

Round 34: (sc, dec) x3 (9)

Round 35: dec x3 (6)

Round 36: decrease, then slip stitch to third stitch. Finish off.

Ears (make two)

With brown yarn:

Round 1: 6 sc in MR (6)

Round 2: inc around (12)

Round 3: slip stitch around (12)

Finish off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Attach the ears on the 25th round of the body, with about 6 stitches between them.

Eyes (make two)

With white yarn:

Round 1: 6 sc in MR (6)

Round 2: slip stitch around (6)

Finish off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Tail

With beige or pink yarn, join on the first stitch of the body, then ch 20.

Row 1: slip stitch in each stitch of the chain, join to body and finish off (19)


Nose


With beige or pink yarn, embroider a nose on the last stitches of the body.
