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SKILL LEVEL: beginner

FINISHED MEASUREMENT

approximately - 3"(7,5cm) around

MATERIALS

- Schachenmayr Nomotta Catania (100% cotton), 50g (1.75oz)/125 mt):

- MW #00236 white – 1 ball or any other sport weight yarn in same color

- small amount of sport – weight yarn in sparkle CW,
- small amount of 3/8"(10mm) white organza ribbon
- small amount of fiberfill

CROCHET HOOK

C - 2(2.75mm) or any size to obtain correct gauge

NOTIONS

- yarn and embroidery needles
- hot glue

GAUGE

first 3 rows = 1/2"(1,5cm) in diameter

This „frosty” Christmas Tree ornament reminds me full of frost and snow Christmas time. The only two colors used in this pattern brings much result.

Make as much balls and bows as you want or how long you want your chain to be.

It can be an addition to other embellishments as well as looks great alone.

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CHRISTMAS BALL

Note: Ball is worked in continuous rounds – see diagram 2 on p. 3. You can make as many balls as you want ☺

- With MW and crochet hook magic ring.

Rnd 1: ch 1, 6 sc in ring, do not join, pm, moving it at the end of each round = 7 sc.

Rnd 2: 2 sc in each sc around = 12 sc.

Rnd 3: [sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc] around = 18 sc.

Rnd 4 - 5: sc in each sc around = 18 sc.

- Stuff with fiberfill hiding beg yarn tail inside too.

Rnd 6: [sc in next sc, sc2tog over next 2 sc] around = 12 sc. Fasten off. Wave in and.



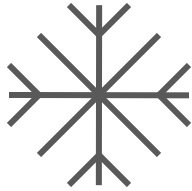
- Thread yarn needle with CW. Referring to detailed diagram 1 on p. 3. and tutorial below embroider snowflake onto each ball.

- Cut approximately 80" (2 m) long tail of CW for every 10 balls. Thread yarn needle with CW. Wave a knot approximately 7" (18cm) from one end. [Thread through the middle of ball, without removing yarn from the needle, secure with strict knot. Make another knot 4" (10cm) from the last one] repeat as many times as many balls you crocheted.

- With satin ribbon make bows one less the balls you have. Hot glue the bows in the middle of 4" (10cm) spaces. Tie a knot leaving a small circle for hanging at each end of CW yarn.

DIAGRAM 1 OF SNOWFLAKE

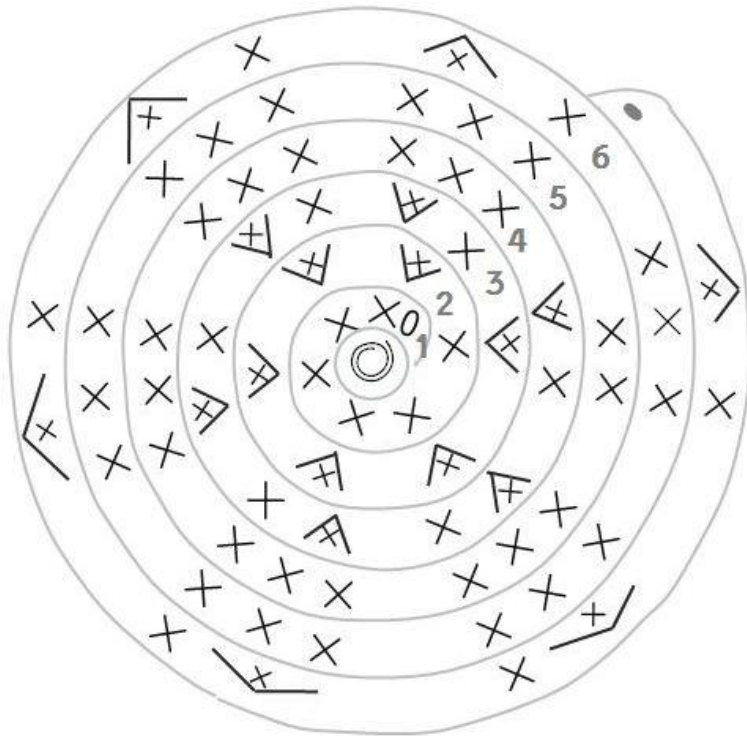


- - sl st

- beg – beginning
- ch – chain
- sc – single crochet
- sl st - slip stitch
- sp - space
- Rnd(s) – round(s)
- [] – work directions in brackets the number of time specified
