## SLOUCH HAT REDUX

**Skill:** advanced  
beginner

**Size:**  
To fit 18" to 22" head

**Yarn:**  
2 balls of  
[Loop-d-Loop](#)  
[Tundra](#)

**Needles:**  
US 11 circular 16"  
long OR US 11 dpns

**Gauge:** 3 sts  
per inch in st st

**Abbreviations:**  
st(s): stitch(es)  
k: knit  
p: purl  
beg: beginning  
pm: place marker

yo: yarn over

k2tog: knit 2 sts  
together

skp (sl 1, k1, pss):  
slip 1 stitch as if to  
knit, knit next st, pass  
slipped stitch over knit  
stitch



## INSTRUCTIONS

Fits a child loose, fits an average woman's head snug.

With US 11 circular 16" long OR US 11 double pointed,  
cast on 44 sts, join to form circle, pm to mark beginning  
of rounds. (slip marker at beg of each round)

Round 1 thru 6: \*k3, p1; repeat from \* around  
Round 7: knit  
Round 8: \*k1, yo, k1, skp; repeat from \* around  
Round 9: \*k2, yo, skp; repeat from \* around  
Round 10: \*yo twice, k2tog, k1, sl 1; repeat from \*  
around  
Round 11: k around (when you come across the double  
yo, knit into the first yo and drop the second yo)  
Round 12: k around  
Round 13: \*k2, yo, skp; repeat from \* around  
Round 14: \*yo twice, k2tog, k1, sl 1; repeat from \*  
around  
Round 15: k around (when you come across the double  
yo, knit into the first yo and drop the second yo)  
Rounds 16, 17, 18: repeat above 3 rounds.  
Round 19: k around  
Round 20: \*k2, yo twice, skp; repeat from \* around  
Round 21: k2, k into yo and drop second loop, \*k3,  
k into first yo and k into back of second yo, k3, k into  
yo and drop second loop; repeat from \* around to last  
stitch, k1  
Round 22: k around to last 2 sts, k2tog  
Round 23: \*k2, yo, skp; repeat from \* around  
Round 24: \*skp, k2; repeat from \* around  
Round 25: \*k2, skp; repeat from \* around

Round 26: \*k2tog, yo, k2; repeat from \* around to last  
3 sts, k2tog, yo, k1

Round 27: \*k2, skp; repeat from \* around to last 3 sts,  
k1, skp

Cut yarn and pull thru rem sts to close.

This hat can be stretched out to almost any size!  
The merino wool and the stitch pattern makes it grow.

For women's sizes, pull down on the stitches to lengthen  
the hat and pull on the width to make it larger.  
Right off the needles it fits a child's head perfectly.
