

LACHESIS AND CO. PRESENTS

BELMONDO

A TRIANGULAR SHAWL WORKED IN A LATTICE PATTERN FROM TIP TO SHOULDERS, WITH OPTIONAL FRINGE.

SIZES

Small (Medium, Large)

GAUGE

Gauge is not important for this project.

MATERIALS

Malabrigo Yarn Twist, 150 yds, 3.5 oz: 1 (2, 2) skeins

US 11/ 8mm (US 13/9mm) 24" circular needles

Yarn needle

Crochet hook for fringe (optional)

SKILL LEVEL

Beginner

ABBREVIATIONS

CO - cast on

k - knit

p - purl

k2tog - knit 2 stitches together

yo - yarn over

BO - bind off

sts - stitches

RS - right side

NOTES

The small version is knit on size 11/8mm needles and the medium and large on size 13/9mm.

The medium can be knit from one skein if the fringe is omitted, but be prepared to use every last inch!

SET-UP ROWS

CO 4 sts.

Row 1 (RS): k

Row 2: k

Row 3: k2, yo, k2

Row 4: k2, p1, k2

Row 5: k2, yo, k1, yo, k2

Row 6: k2, purl to last 2 sts, k2

When these rows are complete, move on to the pattern rows.

PATTERN ROWS

Row 1: k2, yo, (k2tog, yo) repeat to last 3 sts, k1, yo, k2

Row 2: k2, p to last 2 sts, k2

Row 3: k2, yo, k1, (yo, k2tog) repeat to last 2 sts, yo, k2

Row 4: k2, p to last 2 sts, k2

Work the pattern rows until piece measures approximately 18 (17, 25) inches straight up from the CO edge, having just worked a Row 3. Next 2 rows: k all sts. BO all stitches loosely (try using a needle one to two sizes larger than you knit this project with or use your favorite loose BO technique).

FINISHING

Wash and block shawl. Weave in all ends. For fringe, cut 45 (51, 63) 10-12 inch lengths of yarn, divide into 15 (17, 21) groups of 3. With RS facing, beg at the tip of the shawl (CO edge), fold 3 lengths of yarn in half, forming a loop at one end. Thread the loop through the garter st edge of shawl, pull ends through open loop using crochet hook if you prefer, securing the fringe to the shawl. Work from the center tip along the edge of shawl, placing fringe approx. every 4 inches.

Approximate post-blocking measurements, excluding fringe.
