



Cutlery Sleeve

<u>Needed</u>	3mm needle, cable needle, small amount of red (main colour MC) and white (contrast colour CC)
<u>Stitches</u>	k=knit, p=purl, c3f=cross 3 in front (put 3 st from left needle on cable needle in front of work, k3, put 3 st from cable needle back on left needle and knit), ribbing=k2-p2

start with CC

Cast on 16 st and knit 15 rows of ribbing.
Change to MC and facing wrong side (=ws) purl one row.
Next row - right side (=rs)

1 (rs)	k3, p2, k6, p2, k3
2 (ws)	p3, k2, p6, k2, p3
3-4	repeat 1 & 2
5 (rs)	k3, p2, c3f, p2, k3
6 (ws)	repeat 2
7-12	repeat 1 & 2
13 (rs)	repeat 5

Rows 5-12 are cable pattern.
Repeat these 8 rows till you reach about 30cm (or desired length) in MC ending with row 9 (rs).
Change to CC and purl one row.
Work 15 rows of ribbing.
Cast off.
Fold in half and sew sides.
Fold over cuff

*If you feel comfortable knitting in the round you can make this sleeve completely seamless.
Start on the bottom with MC and 32 st in Judy's magic cast on (16 st on each needle) and use magic loop knitting.
End with 15 rows ribbing in CC.*
