

Merlin



This pattern is inspired by the neckerchief Merlin sports in the BBC programme, Merlin. While his is made with a woven fabric this pattern will give you a crochet one in a similar style. This neck scarf is perfect for men or women, is easy & it works up speedy fast in single crochet. This is written for my yarns (Nerd Girl Yarns) but you could use any sock weight with enough yardage.

Materials:

- 1 skein Nerd Girl Yarns Swagger or Nerd Girl Yarns Bounce & Stomp (I used the entire skein shy 5-10 yards)
- Size G crochet hook (or hook that achieves desired gauge, this will be a personal preference for how you want your finished fabric to look and drape)
- Darning needle for weaving in ends

Abbreviations:

sc: single crochet
fl: front loop
bl: back loop
ch: chain

Directions:

Chain 3

Row 1) Sc in 1st chain front loop, sc in second crochet bl then sc in fl. Ch 1, turn.

Row 2) Sc in front loop on turning chain, then sc in front loop across until last sc. In last sc, sc in back loop then sc in front loop. Ch 1, turn.

Repeat row two until desired size then proceed to finishing row.

Finishing the last row: Sc in each sc across (do not increase on this row).

Weave in ends & *lightly* block scarf.
