

# Nimble



When I work or knit I like to have mitts that fit close. These mitts have no thumb, just a thumb opening and they also stop at the knuckles to leave the fingers free to be nimble.

These are well fitted mitts with negative ease, they fit my small hands nicely but also stretch to fit larger hands with several inches of give. These are easy, a gender neutral style, and super fast - you can make them and wear them the same night.

**Measurements:** 6.5" long

**Gauge:** 4 sts & 6 rows per inch in stockinette

## Supplies:

Less than one skein of NGY Trifecta or Clever will make a pair, in fact you can probably make about 3 pairs if you knit them without modifications. The pairs I have made used 35g of yarn in Trifecta.

US 8 32" circular knitting needles -I worked this in magic loop but you could easily make yours on DPNs.

Tapestry needle for sewing in ends

Optional: stitch marker for marking the beginning of your round.

**Key:** k - knit; p - purl; m - make a stitch using your favorite method.

## Instructions:

Cast on 24 then join for working in the round being careful not to twist your stitches.

Work K1P1 ribbing for 8 rounds.

Work in stockinette stich only knitting for 18 rounds.

Thumb opening:

K2, bind off 4 stitches, knit rest of round.

K2, m3, knit rest of round.

K5, m1, knit rest of round.

Knit 5 rounds.

Work K1 P1 ribbing for 8 rounds.

Bind off loosely.

Weave in ends.

Repeat for second mitt.
