

Rectangle Garter Shrug



Supplies:

Four skeins Araucania Chacabuco Multy or other super bulky cotton yarn. I assume you could use wool or acrylic but I fear it wouldn't drape as well. Size 10 circular needles (that will hold 38" of knitted fabric as you work).

Gauge:

Approximately 10 knit sts = 4 inches

Knitting Instructions:

Cast on 101 sts.

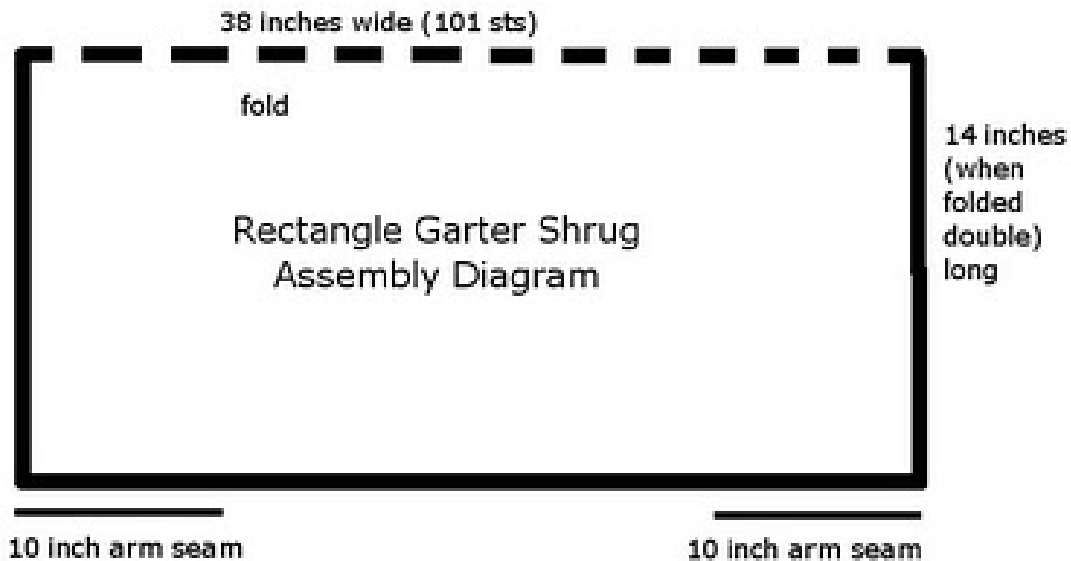
Knit in garter stitch for 28".

Bind off.

Sewing & Assembly Instructions:

Finished rectangle measures 38" x 28". Fold right sides together in half so that you have a rectangle

measuring 38" x 14" (long and skinny). Along the bottom (unfolded side) sew up 10" on one end, leave 18" open in the middle and sew up 10" on other end. Weave in ends.
