

Möbiusly

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This wonderful, simple scarf is full of all sorts of geometric fun! It was inspired by Cat Bordhi's Möbius knitting video and my love for nerdy things :)

Materials:

- 250-300 yards of any worsted weight yarn (I used hand-dyed Pattons Classic Wool)
- US Size 9 (5.5mm) circular needle with a long cable
- Tapestry needle/crochet hook

Directions:

- Cast on 200 stitches as shown in [this video](#)¹ by Cat Bordhi (I know you may be tempted to do your normal cast on here, but it won't work. Watch the video and you'll see why.)
- Round 1 (and all odd rows): K around
- Round 2: *k2tog, YO* around
- Round 4: *YO, k2tog* around
- Repeat rounds 1-4 until you have reached your desired width. Note that the scarf will likely curl in a bit.
- Knit one more round.
- Bind off all stitches.
- Weave in ends and block.
- WEAR AND ENJOY!
