

Antique Rose Cloche Hat



Stylish winter hat that is warm as well as pretty!

Materials

- 1 x knit picks mighty stitch worsted weight
- 1 x 5.5mm hook
- 1 x 4mm hook
- 1 x button

- Sewing thread for securing button.

Gauge

11 rows/15hdc (htr) per 10cm x 10cm

Measurements

From top to edge of brim when laying flat = 22cm

Approximately 56cm around band where smaller stitches are.

Abbreviations (US terms & UK terms)

US TERMS	UK TERMS
ss slip stitch	ss slip stitch
sc single crochet	dc double crochet
hdc half double crochet	htr half treble

Pattern Notes:

This pattern can be adjusted to fit the size of your head.

Size as made will fit most (I have a biggish head and really thick hair!).

Before sewing on the button I turned the hat so that the working side was inside so that the brim curled up instead of down.

Each round is finished by slip stitch into the first stitch of the round (not the initial chain stitches)

The initial chain stitch is not counted, total stitches at the end of the round is in brackets. Don't stress if you miss a stitch or two, adjust as necessary – as a guide, each round increases by 8 stitches.

Where a hook size is not mentioned, use the larger hook.

Pattern (US terms)

Start with a magic ring

Round Number	Instruction
Rnd 1	8 hdc in the magic ring ss to the first hdc (8)
Rnd 2	Ch 1 2hdc into each hdc of the previous round ss into 1 st hdc (16)
Rnd 3	Ch 1 *2hdc, 1hdc* into first two stitches repeat from * in remaining stitches ss into 1 st hdc (24)
Rnd 4	Ch 1 *2hdc into first stitch, 1hdc into next 3 stitches* repeat from * in remaining stitches ss into 1 st hdc (32)
Rnd 5	Ch 1 *2hdc into first stitch, 1hdc into next 4 stitches* repeat from * in remaining stitches ss into 1 st hdc (40)
Rnd 6	Ch 1 *2hdc into first stitch, 1hdc into next 5 stitches* repeat from * in remaining stitches ss into 1 st hdc (48)
Rnd 7	Ch 1 *2hdc into first stitch, 1hdc into next 6 stitches* repeat from * in remaining stitches ss into 1 st hdc (56)
Rnd 8	Ch 1 *2hdc into first stitch, 1hdc into next 7 stitches* repeat from * in remaining stitches ss into 1 st hdc (64)

Round Number	Instruction
Rnd 9	Ch 1 *2hdc into first stitch, 1hdc into next 8 stitches* repeat from * in remaining stitches ss into 1 st hdc (72)
Rnd 10	Ch 1 *2hdc into first stitch, 1hdc into next 9 stitches* repeat from * in remaining stitches ss into 1 st hdc (80)
Note: Adjust to size of head here before continuing to next section - increase 8 stitches per round to make wider or stop at the row that will fit your head size and continue from the row below.	
Rnd 11-22	Ch 1 1hdc into each stitch ss into 1 st hdc (80)
Note: this is where you can adjust the depth of the hat. If you want the brim to sit lower continue to more rows, if you want it shorter, do fewer rows. I have made it so that the brim sits in the middle of my forehead and the top of the hat does not fit snug to my head.	
Rnd 23	Switch to smaller hook Ch 1 1hdc into each stitch ss into 1 st hdc (80)
Rnd 24-26	Keep with smaller hook Ch 1 1sc into each stitch ss into 1 st sc (80)
Rnd 27	Keep to smaller hook Ch 1 1hdc into each stitch ss into 1 st hdc (80)
Rnd 28	Switch back to larger hook Ch 1 *2hdc into first stitch, 1hdc into next 10 stitches* repeat from * in remaining stitches ss into 1 st hdc (88)
Rnd 29	Ch 1 *2hdc into first stitch, 1hdc into next 10 stitches* repeat from * in remaining stitches ss into 1 st hdc (96)
Rnd 30	Ch 1 *2hdc into first stitch, 1hdc into next 10 stitches* repeat from * in remaining stitches ss into 1 st hdc (104)

Once finished, sew desired button onto the band where the stitches with the smaller hook were made – I suggest that you make sure the “seam” that is generated from the initial stitch for each round is placed towards the back.

Pattern (UK terms)

Start with a magic ring

Round Number	Instruction
Rnd 1	8 htr in the magic ring ss to the first hdc (8)
Rnd 2	Ch 1 2htr into each htr of the previous round ss into 1 st hdc (16)
Rnd 3	Ch 1 *2htr, 1htr* into first two stitches repeat from * in remaining stitches ss into 1 st htr (24)
Rnd 4	Ch 1 *2htr into first stitch, 1htr into next 3 stitches* repeat from * in remaining stitches ss into 1 st htr (32)
Rnd 5	Ch 1 *2htr into first stitch, 1htr into next 4 stitches* repeat from * in remaining stitches ss into 1 st htr (40)
Rnd 6	Ch 1 *2htr into first stitch, 1htr into next 5 stitches* repeat from * in remaining stitches ss into 1 st htr (48)

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Rnd 7	Ch 1 *2htr into first stitch, 1htr into next 6 stitches* repeat from * in remaining stitches ss into 1 st htr (56)
Rnd 8	Ch 1 *2htr into first stitch, 1htr into next 7 stitches* repeat from * in remaining stitches ss into 1 st htr (64)
Rnd 9	Ch 1 *2htr into first stitch, 1htr into next 8 stitches* repeat from * in remaining stitches ss into 1 st htr (72)
Rnd 10	Ch 1 *2htr into first stitch, 1htr into next 9 stitches* repeat from * in remaining stitches ss into 1 st htr (80)
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Rnd 11-22	Ch 1 1htr into each stitch ss into 1 st htr (80)
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Rnd 23	Switch to smaller hook Ch 1 1htr into each stitch ss into 1 st htr (80)
Rnd 24-26	Keep with smaller hook Ch 1 1dc into each stitch ss into 1 st dc (80)
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
