

# GLACIER STOCKING SOCKS

## MATERIAL

Yarn Bernetta Wolle Napoli (120m/133 yard/50g) 1 skein dark blue and about 20 g light blue

Needles dpns 3.5 mm / US 4 size

## SIZE

Bigger enough to put some gifts into it!

## GAUGE

22 st / 32 rows = 10 cm / 4" over stockinette stitch

Not important to get the gauge here.

## ABBREVIATION

k: knit

p: p

M: increase

st: stitch

w&t: wrap next stitch and turn the work.

## TOE

Cast on 20 st with either figure-eight, Turkish or Judy's magic

Knit 1 row dividing the stitches on 4 needles (5 st per needles). Then begin toe increase:

Row 1: (k1, M1, k9, M1) 2 x

Repeat this row until you have 68 st on the needles (17 st per needle), then knit 1 row.

## FOOT

Begin glacier chart on the whole stitches. (2 pattern repeat).

Knit from row 1 to 24.

Then knit 2 rows.

## HEEL

At this point, begin the short row heel as follow:

Row 1: k 32 st of the sole stitches, wrap next st, and turn the work

Row 2: p 30 st, wrap next st, turn the work

Row 3: k 29 st, (to 1 st before wrapped st) w&t

Row 4: p 28 st, w&t

Row 5: k 27 st, w&

Row 6: p 26 st, w&t

Row 7: k 25 st w&t

Row 8: p 24 st, w&t

Row 9: k 23 st w&t.

Row 10: p 22 st, w&t

Row 11: k 21 st w&t.

Row 12: p 20 st, w&t

Row 13: k 19 st w&t.

Row 14: p 18 st, w&t

Row 15: k 17 st w&t.

Row 16: p 16 st, w&t

Row 17: k 16 st, k the 8 wrapped st, w&t, the last st wrapped

Row 18: p 24 st, p the 8 wrapped st, w&t, the last st is wrapped

Row 19: k 24, w&t.

Row 20: p 16 st, w&t

Row 21: k 16, k w st, w&t

Row 22: p 17, p w st, w&t

Row 23: k 18, k w st, w&t

Row 24: p 19, p w st, w&t

Row 25: k 20, k w st, w&t

Row 26: p 21, p w st, w&t

Row 27: k 22, k w st, w&t

Row 28: p 23, p w st, w&t

Row 29: k 24, k w st, w&t

Row 30: p 25, p w st, w&t

Row 31: k 26, k w st, w&t

Row 32: p 27, p w st, w&t

Row 33: k 28, k w st, w&t

Row 34: p 29, p w st, w&t

Row 35: k 30, k 2 last w st, knit to the end of row.

Knit 1 round knitting the 2 wrapped st.

The heel is now complete.

## LEG

Continue with glacier chart 2 times around.

Knit from row 1 to 24

Knit 3 rows in dark blue, then one more time from row 1 to 24 of the glacier chart.

Knit 3 rows more in dark blue.

## FINISHING

Continue in p1, k1 for ribbing for the desired length (here 4 ribbing rounds). Knit another row with a sl1 with yarn in front, k1. Knit the last row with a p1, sl1 with yarn in back.

After these 2 last rows you cast-off with an Italian cast-off (tubular cast-off). Don't bind off the last loop, chain 20 st. with a hook and sew in end.

Et voilà.
