

CROCHET CHUBBY CARROT PATTERN

MATERIALS:

*****You can use any worsted weight/
- cat. 4 yarns. You can even use
- yarns of different weights as long
- as you make sure you choose a
- hook size that will prevent gaps
- where the stuffing will show
- through*****

***Red Heart Soft Yarn**

- Tangerine (less than 50 yards)
- Guacamole (very small amount)

***Sewing needle with large eye**

***Polyester stuffing**

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ABBREVIATIONS

Ch	Chain
TCh	Turning Chain
SC	Single Crochet
st (sts)	Stitch (stitches)
SC Dec	Single Crochet Decrease (or SC 2 together)
sl st	Slip Stitch

SIZE:

Small: 3 ½" tall

Medium: 4 ½" tall

Large: 6" tall

HOOK:

G Hook (4 mm)

GAUGE:

20 SC sts x 19 rows = 4" x 4" working with G Hook (4 mm). It is only necessary to check your gauge if you want your carrots to be the same size as mine. Otherwise, just make sure you use a small enough hook to not leave gaps between your stitches large enough for the stuffing to show through.

HELPFUL NOTES

*When you see ** followed by a number, that is indicating the number of stitches you should have done in that row or round. Chains & slip stitches do not count in this total.

*Instructions within brackets [] are a set and need to be done the total number of times indicated after the brackets. A set also can be done all in one stitch if indicated after the brackets.

*If you are not familiar with a magic loop (magic circle) then you can start with a ch 2 and SC the indicated number of sts in 2nd ch from hook. Or you can refer to YouTube tutorials.



SMALL CARROT- Start with tangerine (orange) and G hook. Work in continuous rounds. Stuff as you go.

Rnd 1: Begin with magic loop of 5 SC **5 sts

Rnd 2: SC in each st around **5 sts

Rnd 3: [SC in next st, 2 SC in next st] 2 times, SC in next st **7 sts

Rnd 4: [SC in next st, 2 SC in next st] 3 times, SC in next st **10 sts

Rnd 5: SC in each st around **10 sts

Rnd 6: 2 SC in each st around **20 sts

Rnds 7-8: SC in each st around **20 sts

Rnd 9: [SC Dec] 10 times **10 sts

Rnd 10: 2 SC in each st around **20 sts

Rnd 11: [SC in next st, 2 SC in next st] 10 times **30 sts

Rnd 12: SC in each st around **30 sts

Rnd 13: [SC in next st, SC Dec] 10 times **20 sts

Rnd 14: [SC Dec] 10 times **10 sts

FINISH STUFFING HERE

Rnd 15: [SC Dec] 4 times, sl st in next st (leave the remaining st unworked) **4 sts

Finish off and attach guacamole (green) in same st

Rnd 16: [Ch 9, sl st in next st] 5 times (See Figure A), ch 9, sl st in st you attached your green in.

Finish off leaving tail for sewing.

MEDIUM CARROT- Start with tangerine (orange) and G hook. Work in continuous rounds. Stuff as you go.

Rnd 1: Begin with magic loop of 6 SC **6 sts

Rnd 2: SC in each st around **6 sts

Rnd 3: [SC in next 2 sts, 2 SC in next st] 2 times **8 sts

Rnd 4: [SC in next 3 sts, 2 SC in next st] 2 times **10 sts

Rnd 5: [SC in next 4 sts, 2 SC in next st] 2 times **12 sts

Rnd 6: SC in each st around **12 sts

Rnd 7: [SC in next 3 sts, 2 SC in next st] 3 times **15 sts

Rnd 8: SC in each st around **15 sts

Rnd 9: 2 SC in each st around **30 sts

Rnds 10-12: SC in each st around **30 sts

Rnd 13: [SC Dec] 15 times **15 sts

Rnd 14: 2 SC in each st around **30 sts

Rnd 15: SC in each st around **30 sts

Rnd 16: [SC in next st, 2 SC in next st] 15 times **45 sts

Rnds 17-20: SC in each st around **45 sts

Rnd 21: [SC in next st, SC Dec] 15 times **30 sts

Rnd 22: SC in each st around **30 sts

Rnd 23: [SC Dec] 15 times **15 sts

Rnd 24: [SC in next st, SC Dec] 5 times **10 sts

FINISH STUFFING HERE

Rnd 25: [SC Dec] 3 times, sl st in next st (leave the remaining 3 sts unworked) **3 sts

Finish off and attach guacamole (green) in same st

Rnd 26: [Ch 12, sl st in next st] 6 times, ch 12, sl st in st you attached your green in.

Finish off leaving tail for sewing.

LARGE CARROT- Start with tangerine (orange) and G hook. Work in continuous rounds. Stuff as you go.

Rnd 1: Begin with magic loop of 6 SC **6 sts

Rnd 2: SC in each st around **6 sts

Rnd 3: [SC in next st, 2 SC in next st] 3 times **9 sts

Rnd 4: SC in each st around **9 sts

Rnd 5: [SC in next 2 sts, 2 SC in next st] 3 times **12 sts

Rnd 6: SC in each st around **12 sts

Rnd 7: [SC in next 3 sts, 2 SC in next st] 3 times **15 sts

Rnd 8: SC in each st around **15 sts

Rnd 9: [SC in next 4 sts, 2 SC in next st] 3 times **18 sts

Rnd 10: SC in each st around **18 sts

Rnd 11: 2 SC in each st around **36 sts

Rnds 12-16: SC in each st around **36 sts

Rnd 17: [SC Dec] 18 times **18 sts

Rnd 18: 2 SC in each st around **36 sts

Rnd 19: SC in each st around **36 sts

Rnd 20: [SC in next st, 2 SC in next st] 18 times **54 sts

Rnds 21-25: SC in each st around **54 sts

Rnd 26: [SC in next st, SC Dec] 18 times **36 sts

Rnd 27: SC in each st around **36 sts

Rnd 28: [SC Dec] 18 times **18 sts

Rnd 29: [SC in next st, SC Dec] 6 times **12 sts

FINISH STUFFING HERE

Rnd 30: [SC Dec] 4 times, sl st in next st (leave the remaining 3 sts unworked) **4 sts

Finish off and attach guacamole (green) in same st

Rnd 31: [Ch 15, sl st in next st] 7 times, ch 15, sl st in st you attached your green in.

Finish off leaving tail for sewing.

ASSEMBLY

STEP 1: Hide orange tail and green starting tail. You can weave yours in, but I just use the back of my hook to shove them down through the hole left at the top of the carrot.

STEP 2: Using green finishing tail, sew the opening closed using a whipstitch (See Figure B). Hide tail.

STEP 3: Pull leaves up and fan out a bit.
