

Lava Flow

Yarn Mirasol K'acha
60% merino, 25% alpaca,
15% silk. 98 yards per 50g
ball. 3 balls required, though
you will only use a little of
the third ball.

Needles & Notions 5.0 mm (US 8) needles.
Waste yarn and crochet
hook for provisional cast-on.
Cable needle, although you
may prefer to use a double-
pointed needle.

Tension Roughly 4.5 sts/inch.

Size One size will fit most adults.

Instructions:

Using crochet hook and waste yarn, crochet a chain at least 50 sts long. Pick up and knit 48 sts from the bumps on the back of the crochet chain.

Rows 1-10: [K2, P2] 12 times.

Row 11: Cable row.

Rows 12-21: [K2, P2] 12 times.

Work rows 1-21 9 times. If you decide to change the length of the cowl, it's important that you work an odd number of repeats, as the cables will not flow together with an even number of repeats.

Block the cowl flat, stretching out the ribs. Once dry, unpick the provisional cast-on and place all sts on a spare needle for grafting. Match up the ends of the work, then turn one end over (the last stitch on the right will meet the first stitch on the left of the opposite side). This forms the möbius strip. Graft the ends together, making the ribs match as much as possible. Weave in ends, and enjoy.

Notes and Stitch Patterns:

Cable row: Slip 12 sts to cable needle and hold to front of work, [K2, P2] 3 times, [K2, P2] 3 times from cable needle, [K2, P2] 6 times.

st(s): stitch(es)

K: knit

P: purl
