a quick, simple, and reversible scarf ♥ by Tin Can Knits



Learn to knit with Alexa and Emily! *The Wheat Scarf* is the first project in **The Simple Collection** - a learn to knit series with excellent free patterns and clear tutorials.

From your first scarf, to mittens, socks, and sweaters, learn all you need to know to make modern seamless knits for all of your loved ones.

Cast on now and enjoy the ride!

sizing: Finished scarf measures approximately 8 inches wide by 60 inches long.

materials:

- ? **Yarn:** 400 yards worsted / aran weight yarn
(sample shown in [Sweet Fiber Cashmerino Worsted](#) in 'spanish coin')
- Gauge:** 18 sts and 22 rows / 4" in stockinette stitch
14 sts and 28 rows / 4" in garter stitch
- ? **Needles:** US #8 / 5mm needles (or as req'd to meet gauge)
- Notions:** stitch markers, darning needle



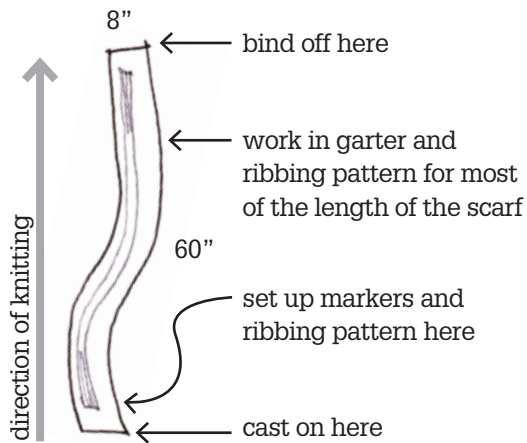
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wheat scarf construction:



pattern: The wheat scarf is knit from end to end.

? Cast on 35 sts. Knit every row until piece measures 3 inches. ?

? **Setup Row:** k16, PM, (k1, p1) 7 times, PM, k5

From this point on the markers remain in place in the work to indicate the divisions between garter stitch and ribbing sections. Simply slip the markers when you come to them.

Row 1: knit to 1st marker, (k1, p1) to 2nd marker, knit to end

Repeat row 1 until scarf measures 57 inches from cast on (*or 3 inches short of desired length*).

Knit every row for 3 inches.

? Bind off all stitches loosely.

? Weave in your ends, and block your scarf.

Wear your scarf around town to stay cozy and flaunt your mad knitting skills!

? abbreviations:

k - knit
p - purl
PM - place marker
st(s) - stitch(es)
