

A fun hat for beginners! Each colorway features lots of color, gentle striping, and thick nubs for a colorful, textured, one-of-a-kind look.

Finished measurements

Approx. 20" circumference (blocked); stretches up to 23"

Materials

- One ball Colorato Nudo (shown in color #10)
- Size 16" US 7 (4.5 mm), 16" US 9 (5.5 mm), US 9 dpns, or size needed to obtain gauge
- 1 stitch marker
- Darning needle



Gauge

16 sts x 21 rounds = 4 inches in stockinette stitch, using larger needle

Hat

With smaller needle, CO 90 sts. Work in k1, p1 rib for 9 rounds or until ribbing measures approximately 2" from cast on. Change to larger needle and work in stockinette stitch (knit every round) until hat measures approximately 7" from cast on edge.

Begin decreases as follows:

Round 1: *K2tog, repeat from *. 45 sts remain.

Round 2 and all even rounds: Knit.

Round 3: *K2tog, repeat from * until 1 stitch remains, k1. 23 sts remain.

Round 5: *K2tog, repeat from * until 1 stitch remains, k1. 12 sts remain.

Round 6: *K2tog, repeat from *. 6 sts remain.

Cut yarn and thread tail through remaining sts, then pull tightly to close the gap. Weave in all ends and block as desired.
